- I. Objective: The Pointe Coupee Parish School District's Objective is for vendors to propose a bundled Chromebook solution that includes a minimum of 180 Chromebooks, Management Console Licenses, Carts, Warranty, device enrollment and asset tagging.

Should a vendor propose a solution that does not meet the specifications listed in the RFP, the vendor must provide sufficient documentation that the District's objective will be met with their solution.

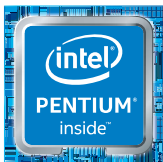

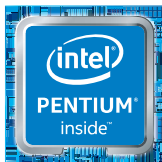

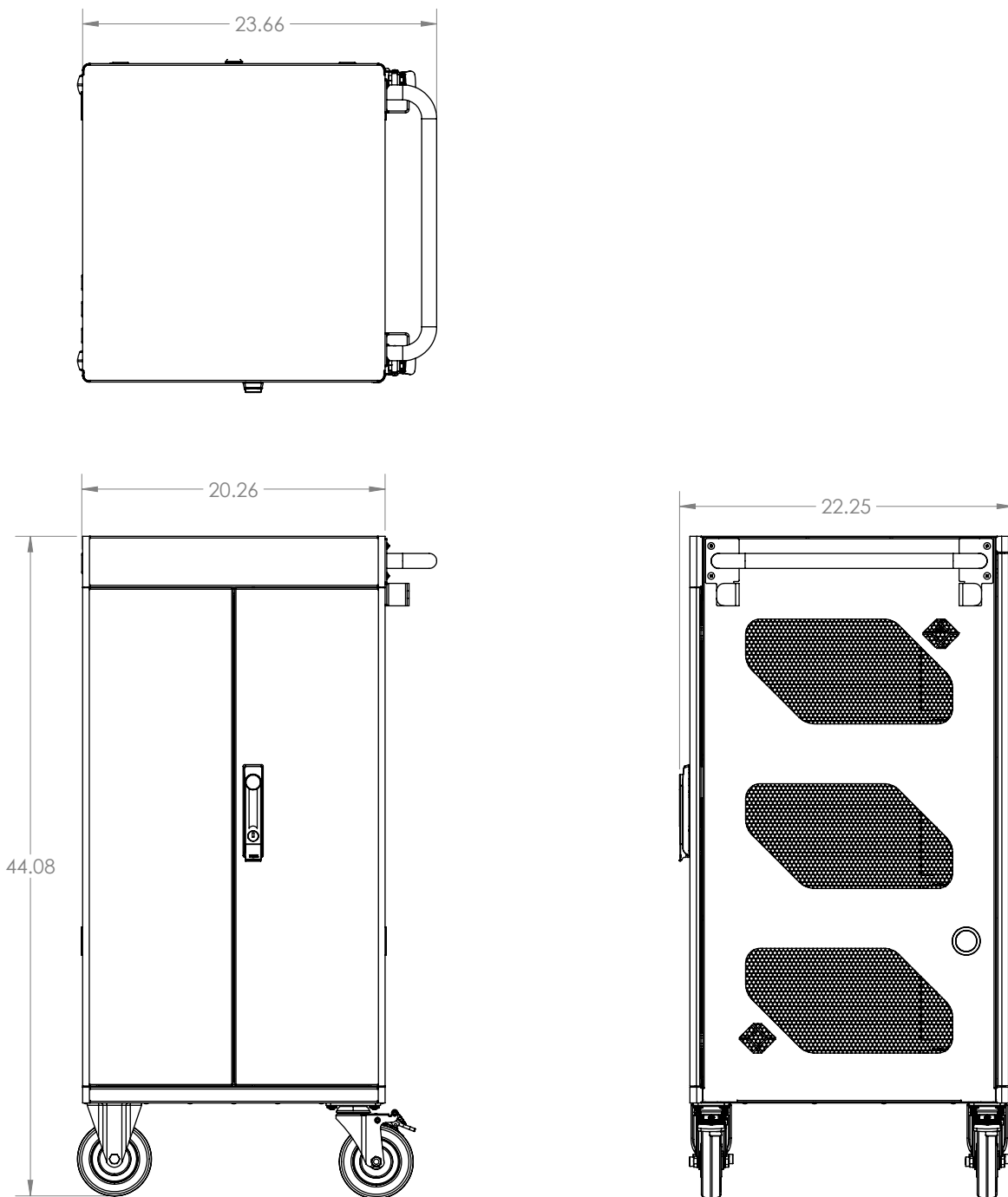
