JEFFERSON PARISH LIBRARY GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

Through its November 27, 2024, BID request, Jefferson Parish Library (JPL) seeks a supplier to provide Services. As stated in the Bid, JPL's objectives are to:

- Provide Labor, materials and equipment necessary for Patron and Staff copiers maintenance
- On-Site Managed Print Services

THE RICOH SOLUTION

Ricoh USA, Inc. (Ricoh) has carefully reviewed the requirements of the bid and all information provided by JPL throughout the bid process. This proposal is the result of our analysis of that information and defines our approach to the requested services. 



Prior to contract execution and at all times thereafter during the term of such contract, contractors must provide and continuously maintain all coverages as required by the foregoing Resolutions, and the contract documents.
