CHANGES TO JEFFERSON PARISH BIDDING PROCEDURES

- **As of January 9, 2019, due to water damage in our main office of 200 Derbigny Street, Suite 4400, Gretna, LA 70053 is closed. Westbank Purchasing Department has temporarily relocated to Paul D. Connick, Sr., Emergency Operations & Communications Center, 910 3rd Street, Gretna, LA 70053. All hand delivered bids and advertised bid openings will be held at this location at the set date and time on the individual Invitation to Bid.**
- **As of November 13, 2018, for all advertised (2:00 pm) bids, the bid tabulation will be released to the vendors 14 days from the bid opening date.**

Other continued changes:

- Bid submissions can be delivered to the Joseph S. Yenni Building, 1221 Elmwood Park Blvd., Suite 404, Jefferson, LA 70123. Bidders may submit bid submission to the East Bank location, pending authorization in each bid package. **Bidders should carefully read and must respond accordingly per the requirements of the bid packages. NOTE: Bidders submitting bids on the day of bid opening, bidders must submit at the West Bank location only.**
- For all advertised sealed bids, written evidence of signature authority must be included with bid submission.
- Current W9 Forms and vendor applications may be submitted at any time; however, if your company is not registered and/or a current W-9 form is not on file, a current W-9 form must be supplied upon contract execution, should you be awarded a contract and/or issued a purchase order.
- **Proof of insurance in the form of a current certificate evidencing coverages is required with bid submission from all bidders.** Bidders must read the insurance requirement attachment included in each bid package for specific instructions. Upon contract execution, successful bidder must produce final insurance certificates in accordance with Jefferson Parish insurance requirements.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS – BID REQUIREMENTS

A. LOUISIANA CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE FOR THIS PROJECT

Must be in the following category: Highway, Street, and Bridge Construction

B. TIMELINES

Except as where provided by law, Bidder agrees that this bid shall be legally binding and may not be withdrawn for a period of forty-five (45) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids. In the event the Owner issues the Letter of Award (copy of adopted resolution awarding bid by Jefferson Parish Council) during this period, the bid accepted shall continue to remain binding pending execution of the Contract.

Bidder agrees to execute the ensuing Contract and will deliver applicable Bonds to secure the faithful performance thereof.

Low Bidder will execute the formal agreement within twelve (12) days after the original date of Owner's Notification of award and will deliver a Performance Bond and Labor and Materials Payment Bond, both in an amount of 50% of the contract price, for any and all Notices to Proceed, within 24 hours of the Low Bidder's receipt of the Notice to Proceed, for the faithful performance of the Contract. If due to emergency conditions, the Contractor cannot obtain and furnish the bonds within 24 hours, the Contractor shall provide written justification for the delay and obtain the bonds as soon as possible. In no case will any payment be issued for work performed by the Contractor until both bonds have been furnished. The cost of the bond premiums will be the responsibility of the Contractor.

PROTESTS: Only those vendors that submit bids in response to this solicitation may protest any element of the procurement, in writing to the Director of the Purchasing Department within 48 hours after bid opening. After consultation, the Parish Attorney's Office will then respond to protests in writing.

Upon full execution of the Contract and receiving a written notice to proceed, the bidder agrees that all work shall be completed as follows: Upon receipt of a "Notice –To-Proceed, by any available method of communication," the Contractor shall begin work within 24 hours and work on a continuous daily basis, unless instructed otherwise by the Director of the Jefferson Parish Engineering Department or the Traffic Engineer Supervisor of the Traffic Division of the Jefferson Parish Engineering Department. Work by the Contractor will continue until the aforementioned Director of the Engineering Department or Traffic Engineer Supervisor determines that services are no longer necessary and issues a "Notice-To-Cease" to the Contractor.

C. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

As this is an Emergency Contract, there will be no provision for liquidated damages.

E. ETHICAL STANDARDS AND COOPERATION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL

Vendor agrees by bid submission to comply with all provisions of Louisiana Law as well as compliance with the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances, Louisiana Code of Ethics, as published on <http://ethics.la.gov> and applicable Jefferson Parish ethical standards and Jefferson Parish Resolution No. 113646 and/or Resolution No. 113647.

It shall be the duty of every parish officer, employee, department, agency, special district, board, and commission; and the duty of every contractor, subcontractor, and licensee of the parish, and the duty of every applicant for certification of eligibility for a parish contract or program, to cooperate with the inspector general in any investigation, audit, inspection, performance review, or hearing pursuant to this chapter. Every parish contract and every bid, proposal, application or solicitation for a parish contract, and every application for certification of eligibility for a parish contract or program shall contain a statement that the corporation, partnership, or person understands and will abide by all provisions of this chapter.

F. REQUIRED AFFIDAVITS

For convenience, all legally mandated affidavits have been combined into one form, entitled THE PUBLIC WORKS BID AFFIDAVIT. All bidders must submit with their bid submission, a completed, signed and properly notarized affidavit in its original format and without alteration in order to be compliant and for the bid to be considered responsive. A scanned copy of the completed, signed and properly notarized affidavit may be submitted with the bid; however, the successful bidder must submit the original affidavit in its original format and without material alteration prior to, or at contract execution. Failure to comply will result in the bid submission being rejected as non-responsive. The Parish reserves the right to award bid to the next lowest responsive and responsible bidder in this event.

G. BID REQUIREMENTS (BID DOCUMENTS, SPECIFICATIONS, BONDS, W-9 AND PAYMENT INFO)

Bidders must review the bid specifications and include any required documentation, including but not limited to the LA Public Works Uniform Bid Form, Bid Security, Corporate Resolution or written evidence of signature authority, and the Public Works Affidavit. Pursuant to LA R.S. 38:2212(B)(3)(b), bidders shall also be responsible for providing any other documentation as required, i.e. federal grant documentation, etc. Please note that the payment and performance bonds must be supplied by the successful bidder upon contract signing. Further, while Jefferson Parish may have these on file, all bidders are encouraged to furnish their current W-9 Form and respective Tax Identification Numbers with bid submission; records on file may be invalid or expired. However, the successful bidder must submit a W-9 Form and respective Tax Identification Number upon contract execution. Failure to do so may result in payment delays. Bidders must comply with all provisions of the General Terms and Conditions as approved by Resolution No. 113646 and/or 113647. A copy of these terms and resolutions may be obtained from the Office of the Parish Clerk, Suite 6700, Jefferson Parish General Government Building, 200 Derbigny Street, Gretna, LA 70053. Bid Security: Bidders shall provide bid security in the form of a bid bond, cashier's check or money order in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid price (Base Bid and any Alternates). Such security shall become the property of the Owner in the event the successful bidder fails or refuses to execute the Contract or fails to produce performance and payment bonds as previously stipulated.

If submitting online, bidders must submit an electronic bid bond through the respective online clearinghouse bond management system(s) as indicated in the electronic bid solicitation on Central Auction House. No scanned paper copies of any bid bond will be accepted as part of the electronic bid submission.

H. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Bidders must submit with bid submission a current (valid) insurance certificate evidencing required coverages. Failure to comply will cause the bid to be rejected. The current insurance certificate will be used for proof of insurance at time of evaluation. Thereafter, and prior to contract execution, the low bidder will be required to provide final insurance certificates to the Parish which shall name the Jefferson Parish, its Districts Departments and Agencies under the direction of the Parish President and the Parish Council as additional insureds regarding negligence by the contractor for the Commercial General Liability and the Comprehensive Automobile Liability policies. Additionally, said certificates should reflect the name of the Parish Department receiving goods and services and reference the respective Jefferson Parish bid number.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS – CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

If a new contract has not been executed by May 1st, 2019, the existing contract shall automatically extend until the end of the calendar year.

Upon award of a contract to the lowest responsible bidder, the parties will enter into a non-exclusive contract and the Parish retains the right to obtain similar services from additional providers if necessary. The parties intend the Parish to procure other services from contractors when to do so would result in services being obtained in a more prompt and economic manner, due to the emergency nature of the work.

The Parish is not restricted from utilizing its own personnel and equipment or the personnel or equipment of other governmental entities or of any other entities or contractors when the services performed by those entities can be performed with greater speed or less cost to the Parish.

It is understood that this contract will be utilized on an emergency basis only. Under no circumstances should bidders assume that this contract will be utilized for normal daily activities of Jefferson Parish.

As this is an emergency response contract, the actual work to be performed may significantly vary from the estimated quantities. Therefore, Jefferson Parish reserves the right to eliminate items of work and increase or decrease the estimated quantities for items of work to meet existing conditions without allowing for any reevaluation and adjustment to the unit prices for the individual items of work.

Parts and supplies for which there is no price or quantity included in the Agreement shall be paid for at a unit price or lump sum to be agreed upon in advance and in writing, by the PARISH and the CONTRACTOR. Where such price and sum cannot be agreed upon by both parties, the payment to do such work shall be based on a reasonable cost to be established based on historic documentation for similar parts and supplies, or the average cost for similar parts and supplies in the area, or published unit costs from a national cost estimating database.

As this is an emergency response contract, it is understood that the bidder must be able to support all required employees necessary to fulfill the project requirements in a post-disaster environment, including but not limited to: fuel, food, housing, supplies, materials, etc.







CONTRIBUTION AND ACCEPTANCE AGREEMENT

THIS CONTRIBUTION AND ACCEPTANCE AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") is entered into as of March 29, 2019 by and between Traffic Solutions, Inc., a Louisiana corporation ("Transferor"), and Traffic Solutions Louisiana, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("Transferee").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, Transferor desires to contribute and transfer to Transferee, and Transferee desires to acquire, receive and accept from Transferor, all of Transferor's rights, title and interests in and to all of the tangible and intangible assets and rights of any kind or description (including, without limitation, all Benefit Plans and Insurance Policies of Transferor), wherever located, that are owned or leased by Transferor, exclusive solely of the Excluded Assets (as hereinafter defined) (collectively, other than the Excluded Assets, the "Contributed Assets"); and

WHEREAS, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, Transferor desires to contribute to Transferee, and Transferee desires to assume, all of Transferor's operating liabilities (including, without limitation, the obligation to pay, discharge, or perform, as appropriate and when due, all liabilities and obligations of Transferor under each of Transferor's Contracts hereby transferred and/or assigned and works-in-progress, arising from and after the closing of the Purchase Agreement (as hereinafter defined), except to the extent any liability or obligation of Transferor relates to any violation, breach, or default by Transferor occurring prior to the date hereof under such Contracts), and the Current Liabilities (collectively, the "Contributed Liabilities"); which Contributed Liabilities will not include, for the elimination of doubt, any transaction expenses incurred by the Transferor or the Shareholders in connection with this Agreement, the Purchase Agreement or the transactions contemplated hereby and thereby or any liabilities or cleanup costs relating to the underground storage tank leak located at 2950 St. Anthony Ave. as disclosed on Schedule 4.25 to the Purchase Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and the mutual covenants stated herein, and other consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

1. Definitions. As used herein, the term "Excluded Assets" means the assets listed in Schedule 1 hereto.
2. Contribution of Assets and Liabilities. As of the date hereof, Transferor hereby contributes, assigns, conveys, transfers, and delivers to Transferee, all rights, title and interest of Transferor in and to the Contributed Assets and the Contributed Liabilities.
3. Acceptance. Transferee hereby acquires, receives and accepts from Transferor the contribution, assignment, conveyance, transfer and delivery of the Contributed Assets, and Transferee hereby accepts from Transferor the assignment of the Contributed Liabilities and hereby assumes and agrees to pay, perform and discharge the Contributed Liabilities, as and when due.

4. Representations and Warranties of Transferor. Transferor hereby represents, warrants, and covenants to Transferee that the following statements are true and correct:
 - a. Organization and Capacity. Transferor is a corporation duly organized, validly existing, and in good standing under the laws of the State of Louisiana. Transferor has full legal power and capacity to execute and deliver and perform all of its obligations under this Agreement.
 - b. Due Execution; Validity of Agreement. This Agreement has been duly executed and delivered by Transferor, and (assuming due execution and delivery hereof by Transferee) constitutes the valid and binding obligation of Transferor enforceable against Transferor in accordance with its terms.
 - c. Title to Assets. Transferor owns the Contributed Assets beneficially and of record, free and clear of any liens, and has full power and authority to convey the Contributed Assets free and clear of any liens, and upon delivery to Transferee of the Contributed Assets as herein provided, Transferor will convey to Transferee good and valuable title or a leasehold interest to the Contributed Assets, free and clear of any liens.
 - d. Consents. Except as otherwise provided in the Purchase Agreement, all consents, licenses, approvals, or authorizations required with any person or entity required or advisable in connection with this Agreement, the contribution of the Contributed Assets and the Contributed Liabilities, or the consummation of the other transactions contemplated hereby, have been obtained by Transferor.
5. Representations and Warranties of Transferee. Transferee hereby represents, warrants, and covenants to Transferor that the following statements are true and correct:
 - a. Organization and Capacity. Transferee is a limited liability company duly organized, validly existing, and in good standing under the laws of the State of Delaware. Transferee has full legal power and capacity to execute and deliver and perform all of its obligations under this Agreement.
 - b. Due Execution; Validity of Agreement. This Agreement has been duly executed and delivered by Transferee, and (assuming due execution and delivery hereof by Transferor) constitutes the valid and binding obligation of Transferee enforceable against Transferee in accordance with its terms.
6. Further Assurances. Upon the request of any party hereto, the other parties hereto shall, without further consideration, execute and deliver, or cause to be executed and delivered, such other documents and instruments of contribution, conveyance, transfer, assignment, assumption, novation, and/or confirmation, and shall take, or cause to be taken, such further or other reasonable actions as any party hereto may deem necessary or desirable to carry out the intent and purposes of this Agreement and to consummate and give effect to the transactions contemplated hereby.



All questions concerning the construction, validity, enforcement and interpretation of this Agreement shall be governed by the internal laws of the State of Delaware without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law provision or rule (whether of the State of Delaware or any other jurisdictions) that would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdictions other than the State of Delaware; however, any judicial proceeding must be brought in any court of competent jurisdiction, either, with respect to state court proceedings, within the State of Delaware, or, with respect to federal court proceedings, in the District of Delaware.
12. Purchase Agreement. This Agreement is entered into prior to the transactions contemplated by the Unit Purchase and Contribution Agreement (the "Purchase Agreement"), dated March __, 2019, among Midwest Traffic Control, LLC, Midwest Traffic Holding, LLC, Transferor, Transferee, and the Shareholders of Transferor. 
