By submitting a bid, vendor agrees to comply with all provisions of Louisiana Law as well be in compliance with the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances, Louisiana Code of Ethics, applicable Jefferson Parish ethical standards and Jefferson Parish Resolution No. 136353 and/or Resolution No. 141125 as amended.

Jefferson Parish adheres to the Louisiana Code of Governmental Ethics, contained in Louisiana Revised Statutes Annotated, R.S. 42:1101, et seq. Vendor/Proposer by this submission, warrants that there are no "conflicts of interest" related to this procurement that would violate applicable Louisiana Law. Violation of the Louisiana Code of Governmental Ethics may result in rescission of contract, permit or licenses, and the imposition of fines and/or penalties, without contractual liability to the public in accordance with applicable law.

All vendors submitting bids should register as a Jefferson Parish vendor if not already yet registered. JEFFERSON PARISH requires all products to be new (current) and all work must be performed according to standard practices for the project. Unless otherwise specified, no aftermarket parts will be accepted. Unless otherwise specified, all workmanship and materials must have at least one (1) year guaranty, in writing, from the date of delivery and/or acceptance of the project. Any deviations or alterations from the specifications must be indicated and/or supporting documentation supplied with bid submission.

Bidders should submit all questions in writing via email to the Purchasing Specialist's email address as indicated above, no later than Five (5) working days prior to the bid opening. Every contract or order shall be awarded to the LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, taking into consideration the CONFORMITY WITH THE SPECIFICATIONS and the DELIVERY AND/OR COMPLETION DATE. SPLIT AWARDS MADE TO SEVERAL VENDORS WILL ONLY BE GRANTED TO THOSE DEEMED RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE.

All bid prices shall remain valid for 45 days. Jefferson Parish and the lowest responsive and responsible bidder(s) by mutual written consent may mutually agree to extend the deadline for award by one (1) or more extensions of thirty (30) calendar days.

PROTESTS: Only those vendors that submit bids in response to this solicitation may protest any element of the procurement, in writing to the Director of the Purchasing Department. Written protest must be received within 48 hours of the release of the bid tabulation by the Purchasing Department. After consultation, the Parish Attorney's Office will then respond to protests in writing. (For more information, please see Chapter 2, Article VII, Division 2, Sec. 2-914.1 of the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances.)

PREFERENCE: Unless federal funding is directly spent by Jefferson Parish for this purchase, preference is hereby given to materials, supplies, and provisions produced, manufactured or grown in Louisiana, quality being equal to articles offered by competitors outside the state. "LSA - R.S. 38:2251-2261"

The price quoted for work shall be stated in figures. In the event there is a difference in unit prices and totals, the unit price shall prevail.

Any prospective bidder who fails to attend the conference or remain for the duration shall be prohibited from submitting a bid for the project.
2. Attendance to this pre-bid conference is optional. However, failure to attend the pre-bid conference shall not relieve the bidder of responsibility for information discussed at the conference. Furthermore, failure to attend the pre-bid conference and inspection does not relieve the successful bidder from the necessity of furnishing materials or performing any work that may be required to complete the work in accordance with the specification with no additional cost to the owner.
3. Contractor must hold current applicable JEFFERSON PARISH licenses with the Department Building Permits. 4. Butterfly Valve (Mechanical Joint End)
5. Butterfly Valve (Flange Joint End)

Contract Terms:

A two (2) year contract for a supply of Gate and Butterfly Valves, for the Jefferson Parish Department of Public Works- all water districts and all Jefferson Parish agencies and municipalities.

Warranty:

Products shall be warranted that they are manufactured in accordance with the applicable material specifications and are free from defects in workmanship and materials for one year after delivery. Any defective items sold under this contract shall be replaced at no cost to the purchaser.

General Specifications:

This specification is prepared for the acquisition of gate valves and butterfly valves.

All items in this bid must be of domestic United States manufacture and meet all criteria set forth by AWWA, ASTM, ANSI, and federal and as specified hereafter.

All pertinent technical specifications and literature may be required upon request. Should technical specifications and literature be requested, bidder(s) will be required to submit said technical specifications and literature within ten (10) days of the request.

Clarification of Terms:

Terms such as "Domestic United States of America Manufacture" and/or "Made in United States" shall mean that every components of these products or items are 100% made, manufactured, assembled, etc. in the United States of America.

The quantities shown on the proposal guide are approximate quantities to be acquired by Jefferson Parish over a two (2) year period. Actual usage will be on an "as needed" basis.

Bid delivery shall include all freight and delivery costs to Jefferson Parish warehouse locations on the East and West Banks of Jefferson Parish.

Technical Specifications:

I. Resilient Seat Gate Valves:

Resilient seat gate valves shall be domestically produced cast or ductile iron and conform to the latest revision of AWWA resilient seated gate valve standard C515 (ductile iron only), be UL listed and FM approved for service to 250 psi, cold water, non-shock water works service and 200 psi fire protection service. Resilient seat gate valves having standard mechanical joint ends shall have dimensions complying with AWWA C111 and ANSI A21.11 to be used with cast iron, ductile iron and Class 200 cast iron O.D. PVC pipe.

Resilient seat gate valves with flanged ends shall have dimensions and drilled connections complying with ANSI B-16.1, Class 125#.

NRS stems shall be case bronze with integral collars in compliance with AWWA. The NRS stuffing box shall have two O-ring seals above the thrust collar and one below. The top two O-rings shall be field replaceable without removing the valve from service.

The operating nut is to be 2" square nut, counterclockwise operation and shall be independent of the wedge and of solid bronze.

Stuffing box shall be attached to the bonnet and bonnet to the body with factory installed type 316 stainless steel bolts and nuts. Blind bolts threaded directly into the body or bonnet will not be acceptable.

The body and bonnet shall be coated both interior and exterior with a fusion bonded heat cured thermo setting material meeting all the application and performance requirements of AWWA C550.

The gasket seal between two surfaces shall employ the use of composition ring type gaskets retained to prevent the possibility of blow out.

Each valve shall be hydrostatically tested at 500 psi and must meet the requirements of both AWWA and UL/FM and be rated for 250 psi AWWA service.

All valves must have ten year published manufacturer's warranty.

Valves shall be as manufactured by Mueller, American Flow Control, M&H, U.S. Pipe, Clow, ARD, Kennedy or Crispin.

II. Butterfly Valves:

All butterfly valves shall be domestically produced and conform to the latest revision of AWWA standard C504 "rubber-seated butterfly valves", Class 150B. All butterfly valves shall operate so that the valve will open when turning the two (2) inch operating nut in a counter-clockwise direction.

Valves bodies shall be cast iron, ASTM A-126, Class B. Valves shall be short body design with mechanical joint ends or flanged ends, Class 150B. Valves shall be furnished complete without accessories.

Valves shafts shall be manufactured of 304 stainless steel and shall be of the "stub shaft" or "through shaft" type. If a stub shaft is used, it shall be inserted into the valve disc hubs for a distance of at least 1-½ shaft diameters. The disc/shaft connection shall be achieved with a pin that penetrates completely through the center of the valve shaft. The valve shaft diameter extending through the valve bearings into the valve disc shall be not less than specified in table 4 of the AWWA C504-80. The shaft shall have a packing gland or O-ring in the top trunnion of the valve body where the shaft protrudes for the operator connection. Where a packing gland is used, packing shall be of the self-adjusting "V" type, or approved equal. Packing gland and packing must be accessible without valve disassembly.

The disc shall be cast or ductile iron with disc edges of type 316 stainless steel. On valves 30" or larger, the disc shall be a flow through design and shall have an offset design to provide 360 degree uninterrupted seating.

The valve seats shall be Buna-N or natural rubber and shall be secured to either the valve body or disc. Rubber seats on the disc shall be bonded and vulcanized to stainless steel disc ring to insure proper alignment. On valves 30" and larger, valve seats shall be designed to permit mechanical adjustment or replacement in the field. If the rubber seat is on the disc, the 316 stainless steel body seat shall have an O-ring behind it to ensure bi-directional shut off at 150 psi.

The valve shall be equipped with a manual actuator consisting of a totally enclosed traveling nut type mechanism set on the side of the valve for operating with a 2-inch operating nut set in the vertical position. Valves utilizing actuators with right angle drives will not be permitted. The manual operator shall be of a design by the valve manufacturer complying with the latest revision of AWWA C504, and capable of withstanding 450 foot pound actuator input torque against the stops.

All interior and exterior surfaces of the butterfly valves are to be coated by manufacturer prior to shipment with a fusion bonded heat cured thermo setting material meeting all performance and application requirements conforming to AWWA C550.

316 stainless steel nuts and bolts shall be supplied for the valve body and stuffing box.

Valves shall be as manufactured by Mueller, M&H, Clow, ARD, Kennedy, Crispin, APCO/Dezurik or Henry Pratt.

III. Double Disc Gate Valves:

Valves shall be manufactured in accordance with AWWA Standard C500-93. Valves 12" and smaller shall be designed for 200 psi water working pressure and 150 psi for valves 14"-48" inclusive. Valves shall have (MJ, Flanged or as indicated on plans) ends and shall

have clear waterway equal to the full nominal diameter of the valve. Valves shall be double disc parallel seat type with (non-rising, rising) stems opening by turning (left, right) and provided with (2"square nuts, hand wheel), with arrow cast in metal to indicate direction of opening.

Stuffing Boxes shall be "O" ring seal type with two O-rings located in stem above thrust collar in valves without gearing. Sizes 14" through 48" there shall be a bronze bushing meeting ASTM B584.

Valves will be bottom wedging type with two part floating wedge contact. The wedge and hook shall be separate castings and not a one piece casting in valves 4"-36".

Stems shall be in full conformance with AWWA Specs. Sizes 14"-36" bronze ASTM B584 with 80,000 tensile strength, and cast integral stem collar. 42" and 48" shall be type 304 stainless steel.

Stem nuts shall be made of solid bronze independent of hooks, gates and wedges. No pins will be allowed to retain gates to stem nut.

Gates shall be high strength cast iron, sturdily proportioned without pockets on backs. Cam surfaces shall open to bottom. Gate rings shall be rolled into dovetailed grooves under pressure to make one inseparable unit. The gate ring face shall be machined to a smooth finish.

All valves except flanged valves and outside screw and yoke valves are supplied with 2" square operating nuts of high strength cast iron unless otherwise specified. Flanged valves and outside screw and yoke valves are supplied with hand wheels of high strength cast iron unless otherwise specified. Direction of opening is indicated by arrow cast on operating nut skirt or on the rim of the hand wheel.
