Paper bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope. Each sealed envelope containing a bid shall be plainly marked on the outside as State Project No. H.012775 (323) and the envelope shall also bear on the outside the bidder's Louisiana State Contractor's license number. If the bid is hand delivered, the deliverer shall be handed a written receipt.
