Des Allemands Boat Launch - Des Allemands, LA

DDG is providing engineering and design, marine surveys, project management, architectural and landscape architectural services, construction administration and inspection services for the development of an access road, boat launch and parking area. The project site is approximately 110 acres along LA Hwy 632, adjacent to Des Allemands Elementary. Improvements include the park entryway, limestone access road, parking lot, four (4) stall boat launch, restroom facility, and gazebo.

Assumption Parish Administration Building - Napoleonville, LA

The Assumption Parish Police Jury contracted with DDG for the architectural design of a 10,800 square foot administration building in Napoleonville, LA. The first floor of the building houses the police jury meeting room and executive conference room, as well as the mayor's office and support spaces. In a cross court arrangement there will be two volleyball courts with seating for 150 people and two practice basketball courts. The design includes a full service catering kitchen, and the structure will have emergency power to run the entire facility. The center handles local club meetings as well. This project is being funded by the Louisiana Recovery Authority as a result of Hurricane Gustav.

Nicholls State University Coastal Center Facility - Thibodaux, LA

This project consists of a new two story, 33,400 SF building, to be located on the Nicholls State University campus that will provide critical collaborative space needed for the growth of the Coastal Support Program designed to focus on resources and land preservation. The building will have public spaces to include a large open exhibit/lobby space and four public meeting rooms.

Terrebonne Port Commission Multi-Use Complex - Houma, LA

This project involves renovating an existing building for the Terrebonne Port Commission. To create functional spaces, demountable partitions were installed, resulting in three offices, a kitchen, a conference room, and a Board Room for Commission meetings. Notable design elements include a feature wall in the lobby adorned with carved MDF panels that emulate the appearance of water, a custom reception desk reflecting the materials commonly found around the Port, and wooden panel walls in the Board Room.

Assumption Parish Community Center (OCD/DRU) - Napoleonville, LA

Mr. Viguerie was responsible for the client coordination, CDBG application, sub-consultant coordination and overall management of the project. The Assumption Parish Community Center is a 33,800 square foot multipurpose building designed to handle local club meetings, as well as large public gatherings. The structure is designed to withstand category five hurricane winds. The project was funded by the Louisiana Recovery Authority with OCD/DRU funds.



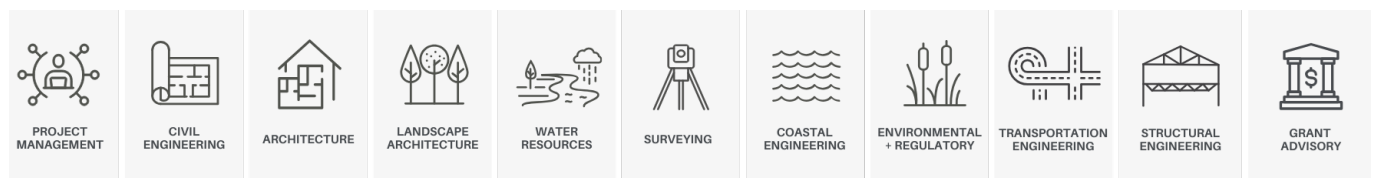

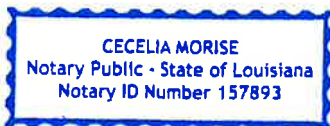
