

Jefferson Parish Methodology

Jefferson Parish is currently using Frontier for access control and Hikvision cameras and VMS for the basis of their security infrastructure. Convergent's intent is to migrate them from Frontier and Hikvision to Genetec for VMS and ACS and Hanwha for Cameras. Convergent believes this to be the correct move for Jefferson Parish in giving them a single pane of glass solution which is user friendly and to a large degree future proof. This also helps the Parish get in compliance with the McCain act by eliminating one of the major noncompliant systems. We will also propose that the Hikvision Cameras be replaced with comparable Hanwha cameras over the course of this contract. Hikvision cameras are known to have existing backdoor access to the networks upon which they exist and are a well known threat to any network upon which they exist and are also known to be made by a company that is owned by the Chinese government. Hikvision is currently banned from federal facilities, something that most state and local agencies have also banned from their facilities. Hikvision hardware and software pose a well defined threat to any network's security.

Convergent can not provide this migration for free but we will work with Genetec to greatly discount the cost of the migration to Jefferson Parish. Because Frontier is mercury based, similar to Genetec, a migration would be fairly quick and will require minimal investment on the ACS side. Convergent would install a Genetec cloudlink in each building and would flash the existing door boards to complete the ACS migration. On the VMS side, Convergent would recommend standing up a Set of Servers in the Parish's data center and would migrate the existing cameras to Genetec. We believe this cost will be necessary in the not too distant future and believe that this design will become the basis of a easily used collaborative platform for the parish to build upon for many years to come.

Financial basis of our bid

Convergent has elected to provide a discount off of MSRP methodology as the basis of our bid. Because manufacture pricing is highly variable and has been in the electronics industry currently and is expected to be unstable for the next couple of years until the microprocessor chip shortage addressed, we believe that providing a consistent discount structure is safer for the vendor and the parish. In the last 2 years, product pricing has increased greater than 50% in several instances, which can quickly cause a contract to become unprofitable, requiring contracts to be rebid. In an effort to provide consistent service to long term contracts, Convergent has found that offering a Percentage off of MSRP is a safer method to both parties than offering up a potentially non future proof price that we know could eventually trigger a default on a contract or a rebid of the contract before the intended date. Convergent will provide a MSRP price list of bid items quarterly to the parish and will promptly notify the parish of unexpected changes. We believe that this will create continuity in service that can not otherwise exist in this market.

Service Methodology

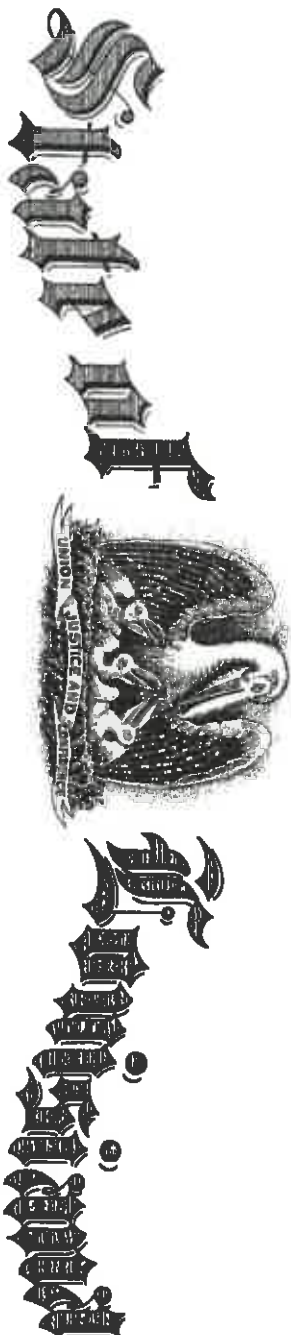
Convergent intends to make a service tech available to Jefferson Parish 2 days a week throughout the lifetime of the contract. The intention is to provide a technician that familiar with the Parish's systems who will become familiar with the parish's sites in an effort to provide continuity of work and to lessen the acclimation time. Convergent utilizes this model with several clients and finds that it provides the greatest value to client's that use Convergent as their primary maintenance provider. This method allows for the same technician to be assigned to the account over long periods of time which reduces that amount of time required prior to the resolution of issues and reduces outages that may effect the parish. This also instills a sense of ownership in the technician that is difficult to duplicate otherwise and allows the tech to operate proactively instead of reactively. This does not mean that the tech selected will be the only person to work on the parish's systems, but that tech will be the site lead if additional resources are needed and will task the team instead of the client which will result in much quicker resolutions and with less supervision required from the parish's staff.

Innovation

Convergent intends to migrate the Parish to a single pane of glass solution by introducing Genetec as the VMS and ACS system. Genetec is already in place at the parish Landfill and is the basis of the New Orleans Real Time Crime Center. Genetec is the leader in physical security and would give the parish an efficiency that it does not currently experience with multiple systems and dispersed recording devices. Convergent is the worlds largest Genetec Dealer and has multiple techs certified in the system in Louisiana. Genetec also has a dedicated Convergent team meaning that Convergent will always have quick and easy access to Customer support if needed.

The use of Genetec will allow parish employees to pull footage from their offices without having to go to the physical site and will allow parish employees to restrict or remove an employee's access rights to any site as needed. Genetec will also allow for collaboration across parish lines if and when the need arises.

While some of our methodologies may seem innovative, they are methodologies learned from years of doing the job, many of which have become our tried and true processes for providing what our clients require where they require it. ATTACHMENT "A"

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Proposers must provide with proposal submission a current (valid) Insurance certificate evidencing required coverages. The current insurance certificate will be used for proof of insurance at time of evaluation. Thereafter, and prior to contract execution, the selected proposer will be required to provide final insurance certificates to the Parish which shall name **the Jefferson Parish, its Districts Departments and Agencies under the direction of the Parish President and the Parish Council** as additional insureds regarding negligence by the contractor for the Commercial General Liability, Workmen's Compensation Insurance and the Comprehensive Automobile Liability policies. Additionally, said certificates should reflect the name of the Parish Department receiving goods and services and reference the respective Jefferson Parish RFP solicitation number

WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE

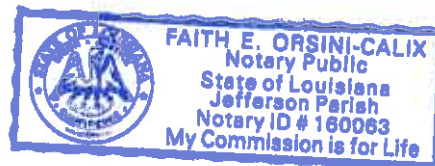
