Section 1.0 – Pre-Bid Conference:

A Non-Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference and inspection shall be held:

All prospective bidders are invited to attend the non-mandatory pre-bid conference, which will be held at the Jefferson Parish Correctional Center, 100 Dolhonde Street, Gretna, LA 70053 on March 31, 2023 at 9:00 AM. Failure to attend the non-mandatory pre-bid conference shall not relieve the bidder of responsibility for information discussed at the conference and does not relieve the successful bidder from the necessity of furnishing materials or performing and completing any work in accordance with the specification with no additional cost to the owner. This conference is held to allow questions to be answered and to inspect the site with the owner's representative.

Section 2.0 – Scope:

We extend this proposal to cover the furnishing of labor, materials, and equipment necessary to replace six (6) Stainless Steel Showers Cabinets in Cell Numbers 2A Left, 2B Left, 2C Right, 3B Left, 3D right, and 4B Left at the Jefferson Parish Correctional Center, located at 100 Dolhonde Street, Gretna LA. 70053

Section 3.0 – License:

A Louisiana State Contractor's License will be required in accordance with LSA R.S. 37-2150 et. seq., and such license number will be shown on the outside of the bid electronic envelope. Failure to comply will cause the bid to be rejected. When submitting the bid electronically, the license number must be entered in the appropriate field in the electronic procurement system. Failure to comply will cause the bid to be rejected." A copy of the license is not required by law; however, they are required to specify their license number on their bid envelope.

3.1 License(s) issued by the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors:

Section 4.0 –Bonds:

- **Surety Bond:** An Electronic bid bond will be required with bid submission in the amount of 5% of the total bid. The vendor shall indicate the electronic bid bond number in the location specified on the electronic bid envelope. No scanned paper copies of any bid bond will be accepted as part of the electronic bid submission.
- **Performance Bond:** A Performance Bond in the amount of 50% of the total contract price will be required. The performance bond shall be produced upon contract execution.
- **Payment Bond:** A payment bond of 50% of the total contract price will be required. The payment bond shall be produced upon contract execution.

Section 5.0 – Quantities/Inspections:

Bidders must inspect the site and perform their measurements to determine the proper quantity of labor and materials, and equipment required to complete this project.

Section 6.0 Submittals:

If the bidder intends to provide materials equal to or better than owner-specified materials, the following shall be provided with their bid:

Section 7.0 - Bid Specifications:

- All materials shall be as specified new.
- All materials shall be installed as per all manufacturer recommendations and guidelines.
- Any concealed damage must be reported immediately to the owner.
- No work outside these specifications shall be performed without approval from a Department of General Services employee.

7.1 Before work begins:

- Successful bidder and an owner's representative shall inspect, document, and take photos of existing building conditions.

7.2 Installation of Six Showers Cabinets:

Design, engineer, supply, and install:

- Remove six (6) existing exhibiting shower cabinets and plumbing fixtures
- One (1) I-Con FXR-S-5110-KD stainless steel shower cabinet in cell numbers 2A Left, 2B left, 2C right, 3B left, 3D right, and 4B left
- One (1) PSH-2 17-1/2-degree security showerhead at the left front of each shower cabinet.
- One (1) I-Con sensor (Button) in each shower cabinet
- Connect each new I-Con system to the existing water supply line in each shower cabinet
- One (1) I-Con 4-1/0 Controller (Programed) in each shower cabinet
- One (1) I-Con 24-volt transformer in each shower cabinet
- One (1) A270 Grid Drains with Tailpieces connected to the existing drain line in each shower cabinet

7.3 FINISHES

- All Finishes and Hardware must be Stainless Steel

Section 8.0 – Hours of Work:

The work to be performed shall be scheduled during regular working hours Monday thru Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Section 9.0 – Material and Workmanship Warranty:

- All workmanship shall have a two (2) year warranty for parts and labor from the successful bidder

Section 10.0 – Existing Structure

Should any damage be caused by this work, the successful bidder shall restore the damage to its original condition with the same type of materials, finish, and workmanship.

Section 11.0 – Unforeseen damages or repairs:

In the event of additional or unseen repairs or conditions, block wall removal or repairs, waste & water line repairs, and ceiling removal or repairs, the contractor must submit a change order to the Department of General Services for approval before additional work can commence.

Section 12.0 – Permits:

Bidder shall obtain any permits required by the Jefferson Parish Department of Inspection and Code Enforcement and any municipality where work is performed.

The bidder shall be responsible for the payment of these permits. All permits must be obtained before the start of any project requiring permits.

Section 13.0 – Liquidated Damages:

Commencing on the thirty-first (31) day following the notice to proceed, liquidated damages will be assessed in the amount of \$300/day.

Section 14.0 – Start of Work Conference and Notice to Proceed:

A "Start of Work Conference" shall be held between the successful bidder and the owner before any work commences.

No work shall be performed until the successful bidder receives a written "Notice to Proceed" to begin work from the Department of General Services.

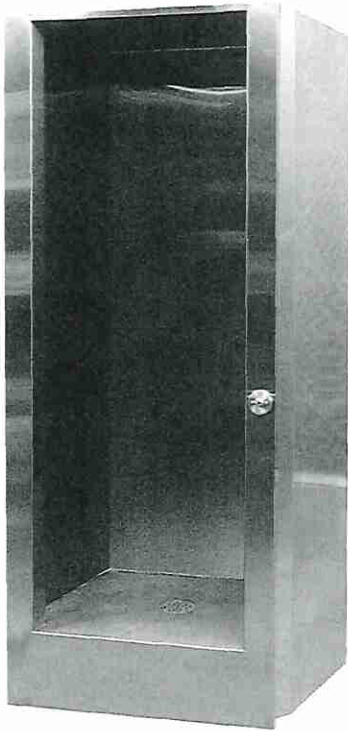

Joints and tamper-resistant, stainless steel fasteners are caulked join the components. Shower flooring is reinforced with heavy channels to prevent flexing. Removable strainer is secured with included tamper-resistant fasteners. Exposed fasteners are tamper-resistant stainless steel.

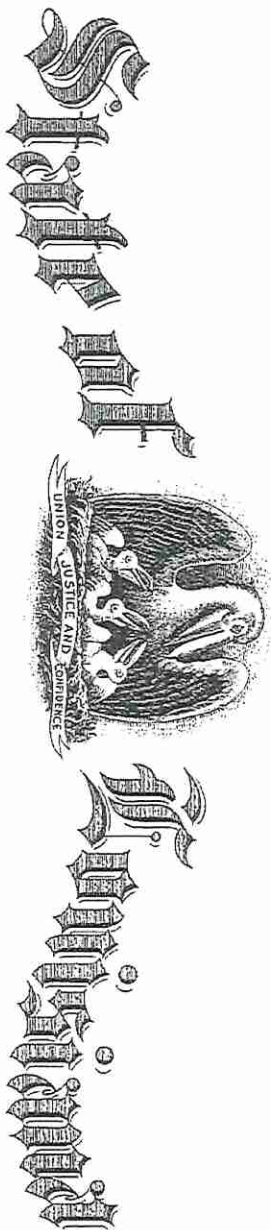

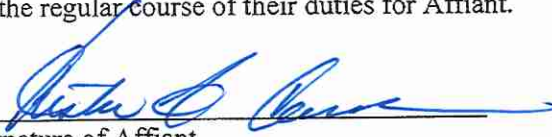

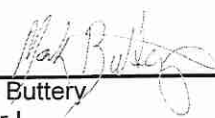
