The following work shall be performed at each test and inspection:

- Test shall be performed semi-annually for a total of four (4) test and inspections on each site listed in Section 6.0 of these specifications.
- All items shall be inspected and tested as per all Local, State, Federal, and Manufacturer guidelines and regulations.
- A copy of the "Department of General Services Fire Suppression System Testing Form" (See Attachment "A") shall be completed at each visit and presented to the owner's representative before the technician leaves the site on all areas listed in Section 6.0 of these specifications.
- At the completion of each inspection and before the technician leaves the site, provide the owner's representative with a list of all devices affiliated with the system that was tested and inspected.
- Within five (5) working days of each test the successful bidder shall provide to the owner a list of all deficiencies found on each system and a cost to repair each item.
- Repairs are not included on this contract
- Each system shall be properly tagged according to the test and inspection results.
- If deficiencies are found and after all repairs and corrections are made the successful bidder shall return within thirty (30) days to re-test and properly tag the system at no extra cost to Jefferson Parish.

Section 8.0-Working Hours:

The work that is to be performed shall be scheduled after normal working hours 5:00 PM - 6:00 AM Monday thru Friday or weekends after 5:00 PM Friday thru 6:00 AM Monday.

Section 9.0 – Existing Structure:

Should any cutting, patching, alteration, addition, or repairs to existing structure, wall, floor, ceiling, or part of building be required of this project, the contractor shall restore the alteration to its original condition, with the same type materials, finish, and workmanship. Precautions must be exercised at all times to safeguard and protect from damage, all Parish, public, and private properties. Any such damages shall remain the sole responsibility of the contractor.

Section 10.0 - Cleaning Area and Safety:

Job site must be clean and free of all litter and debris daily and upon completion of the contract. Passageways must be kept clean and free of material, equipment, and debris at all times. Inflammable material must be removed from the job site daily, because storage will not be permitted on the premises. Precautions must be exercised at all times to safeguard the welfare and safety of the general public, employees of Jefferson Parish, and other Parish officials.

Section 11.0 – Permits:

Successful Bidder shall obtain any and all permits required by the Jefferson parish Department of Inspection and Code Enforcement and the City of Gretna (if applicable). The contractor shall also be responsible for payment of these permits. All permits must be obtained prior to the start of the project.

Certificate of Final Inspection must be submitted to the Department of General Services before final payment is rendered.

Section 12.0 - Invoicing:

The Successful bidder shall submit an individual invoice for each location serviced under this contract to the requesting department. Invoicing information shall be provided to the successful bidder at the Pre- Construction meeting.


