INVITATION TO BID

St. Mary Parish School Board, Child Nutrition Program, is requesting bids on Small Kitchen Equipment for the School Lunch and Breakfast Programs for the 2017/2018 School year, effective August 01, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

Sealed bids will be received at the St. Mary Parish School Board, Central Office Complex, Child Nutrition Program located at 474 LA Hwy 317, mailing address P.O. Box 170, Centerville, Louisiana 70522, **until July 31, 2017 @ 10:00 a.m. at which time they will be opened publicly and read aloud.**

The St. Mary Parish School Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities.

INSTRUCTIONS, GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS

Bid: Bids must be in sealed envelopes addressed to Leonard Armato, Superintendent, St. Mary Parish School Board, Attn: Child Nutrition Department, 474 LA Hwy 317, P.O. Box 170, Centerville, Louisiana 70522, with the envelope plainly marked, **"Sealed Small Kitchen Equipment Bid, Opening 10:00 a.m., July 31, 2017"**.

Bids for small kitchen equipment shall be sent by registered or certified mail with a return receipt requested or hand delivered with a written receipt given.

Bids must be submitted on the official attached bid form. The entire document must be returned including the Contract Section. All certificates included with the bid request must be completed per the instructions and returned with the Bid Proposal Form. Any bid not submitted on this form or without required documentation as listed below will be declared irregular and rejected.

The bid form must be typed or completed in ink. A duly authorized representative of the firm must sign the bid. The person signing the bid must initial any corrections or changes made by erasure, crossing out, writing over or the use of correction fluid. Errors in quoted prices will not relieve the vendor except as provided under Louisiana Revised Statutes. Any notation on the outside of the bid envelope that is intended to amend the bid in any manner will not be considered.

The bidder shall be solely responsible for timely furnishing of bids. Bids received after the time specified for

ORDERS AND DELIVERIES

Deliveries: Vendors shall quote prices for furnishing and delivering small kitchen equipment to the St. Mary Parish School Board Office located at 474 LA 317 Bayou Sale Rd, Centerville, LA 70522. Deliveries will be accepted from 7:00 AM – 3:30 PM excluding 12:00 PM- 12:30 PM. **Delivery time and date must be given 72 hours in advance.**

Inability to Deliver: The vendor must give immediate notice to Child Nutrition Program Purchasing Department of inability to deliver the brand stated. Vendor shall give date that product shall be available and a brand and code of an acceptable substitution. **NO SUBSTITUTIONS ARE ALLOWED WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL FROM THE CHILD NUTRITION SUPERVISOR.** The vendor shall not request authority to substitute unless the quantity of the substitute is equal to or higher than the quality of the original. Any items not meeting the custodial and paper specifications will be shipped back to the vendor at the vendor's expense.

Default to Delivery and Price Correction: The St. Mary Parish Child Nutrition Program reserves the right to cancel that part of the order that the vendor has failed to deliver at the time specified and to credit the invoices for those items not received. **There are no back orders.** In the event of a variation between the price quoted and the price charges on the invoice, the School Food and Nutrition Services reserves the right to adjust the invoice to reflect quoted price.

TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

The School Board reserves the right to revoke the contract if service is not satisfactory.

Remedies for Violation of Contract Terms: The St. Mary Parish Child Nutrition Department will issue warnings to vendor for failure to fulfill contractual obligations including, but not limited to, failure to notify the department of out of stocks, not obtaining substitution approval from the supervisor, inability to deliver, inability to deliver on scheduled delivery day, sending back orders without pre-approval. Three warnings issued to vendor via email may be cause to deem vendor non-responsive, and to remove vendor from future bid list for a period of one (1) year.

Termination for Convenience: The St. Mary Parish Child Nutrition Department may terminate a contract, in whole or in part, whenever the Department determines that such termination is in the best interest of the Department, without showing cause, upon written notice to the vendor. The Department shall pay all reasonable cost incurred by the vendor up to the date of termination. However, in no event shall the vendor be paid an amount that exceeds the price bid for the Work performed. The vendor shall not be reimbursed for any profits which may have been anticipated but which have not been earned up to the date of termination without showing cause. The St. Mary Parish Child Nutrition Department may terminate a contract in whole or in part, in the event food product becomes available through the USDA Commodity program. The Child Nutrition Department shall provide vendor at least 30 days notice of termination due to the USDA Commodity program and for other justifiable reasons.

Termination for Cause: When the contractor has not performed or has unsatisfactorily performed the contract, the Child Nutrition Department may terminate the contract for default. Upon termination for default, payment may be withheld at the discretion of the Department. Failure on the part of the vendor to fulfill contractual obligations shall be considered just cause for termination of the contract. The vendor will be paid for work satisfactorily performed prior to termination less any excess cost incurred by the Department in re-procuring and completing the work.

Pre-Bid Conference: No pre-bid conference will be held.

Preapproved Equal: Any brands requested for preapproved equal must be submitted to our office by **Tuesday, July 11, 2017.**

Taxes: Quoted prices shall not include state or federal sales tax. Price quoted shall remain firm for this period.

Quantities: Quantities stated are the best estimate of the amount to be purchased; however this does not constitute an agreement to purchase these quantities. The quantities may be reduced or increased based upon receipt of USDA donated foods. Currently, St. Mary Parish Child Nutrition Program is considering participation in the CACFP Supper Program which could increase quantities requested.

Piggybacking: The school district will allow piggybacking for up to 20 School Food Authorities.

Grade Standards: Items must meet or exceed the USDA grading requirements for the item and grade specified. A warning will be issued to vendor when any product is found to be lesser grade than that specified.

Size/Pack: The size stated in the specifications represents the approximate size desired. Actual pack size etc. shall be clearly stated on the bid by the vendor. Vendor shall strive to meet the desired pack size.

AWARDS

This is a Line Item Bid. One Brand per item shall be awarded. No substitutions shall be permitted without prior approval from the Child Nutrition Supervisor of St. Mary Parish. Substitutions, if requested, shall be equal to or a higher quality product than item awarded.

Awards shall be made to the lowest responsible vendor and responsive bidder who best meets the terms and conditions of the bid. The award will be made on the OVERALL basis of price.

The Child Nutrition Program reserves the right to buy specialty or brand items when the best interests of the Department shall be served.

Tie Bid: In the event of a tie bid, the award shall be made by a drawing by lot limited to those bidder. The drawing will be witnessed by three persons, and the contract file shall contain the names and addresses of the witness and the person supervising the drawing.

Notice of Acceptance: A written award in the form of a purchase order, contract, written notice of award or any combination of these three to the successful bidder shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party. A copy of the bid tabulation will be emailed to each vendor requesting this.



REQUIRED CONTRACT PROVISIONS FOR PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS IN CHILD NUTRITION PROGRAMS

Required Contract Provisions from Appendix II of 2 CFR Part 200

1. Equal Employment Opportunity. 10. Byrd Anti-Lobbying Amendment (31 U.S.C. 1352)—Contractors that apply or bid for an award exceeding \$100,000 must file the required certification. Each tier certifies to the tier above that it will not and has not used Federal appropriated funds to pay any person or organization for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any agency, a member of Congress, officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a member of Congress in connection with obtaining any Federal contract, grant or any other award covered by 31 U.S.C. 1352. Each tier must also disclose any lobbying with non-Federal funds that takes place in connection with obtaining any Federal award. 
