Contractors may not commence any work under any ensuing contract unless and until all required insurance and associated evidentiary requirements thereto have been met, along with any additional specifications contained in the **Invitation to Bid**. Except as where otherwise precluded by law, the Parish Attorney or his designee, with the concurrence of the Director of Risk Management or his designee, may agree on a case-by-case basis, to deviate from Jefferson Parish's standard insurance requirements, as provided in this Section. Vendors requesting deviation therefrom shall submit such requests in writing, along with compelling substantiation, to the Purchasing Department prior to the bid's due date. Prior to contract execution and at all times thereafter during the term of such contract, contractors must provide and continuously maintain all coverages as required by the foregoing Resolutions, and the contract documents. GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS:

The vendor shall supply all tools, materials, and equipment to provide awards as per specifications listed below.

Vendor shall provide delivery service of all awards and or plaques to an appropriate site as designated by the Department of Parks and Recreation, 6921 Saints Drive, Metairie, LA 70003 or 7437 Lapalco Blvd., Marrero, LA 70072.

Vendor shall box all awards by teams for easy access and to avoid problems sorting.

Each award shall be wrapped with a clear plastic material to prevent scratching and other damage prior to delivery.

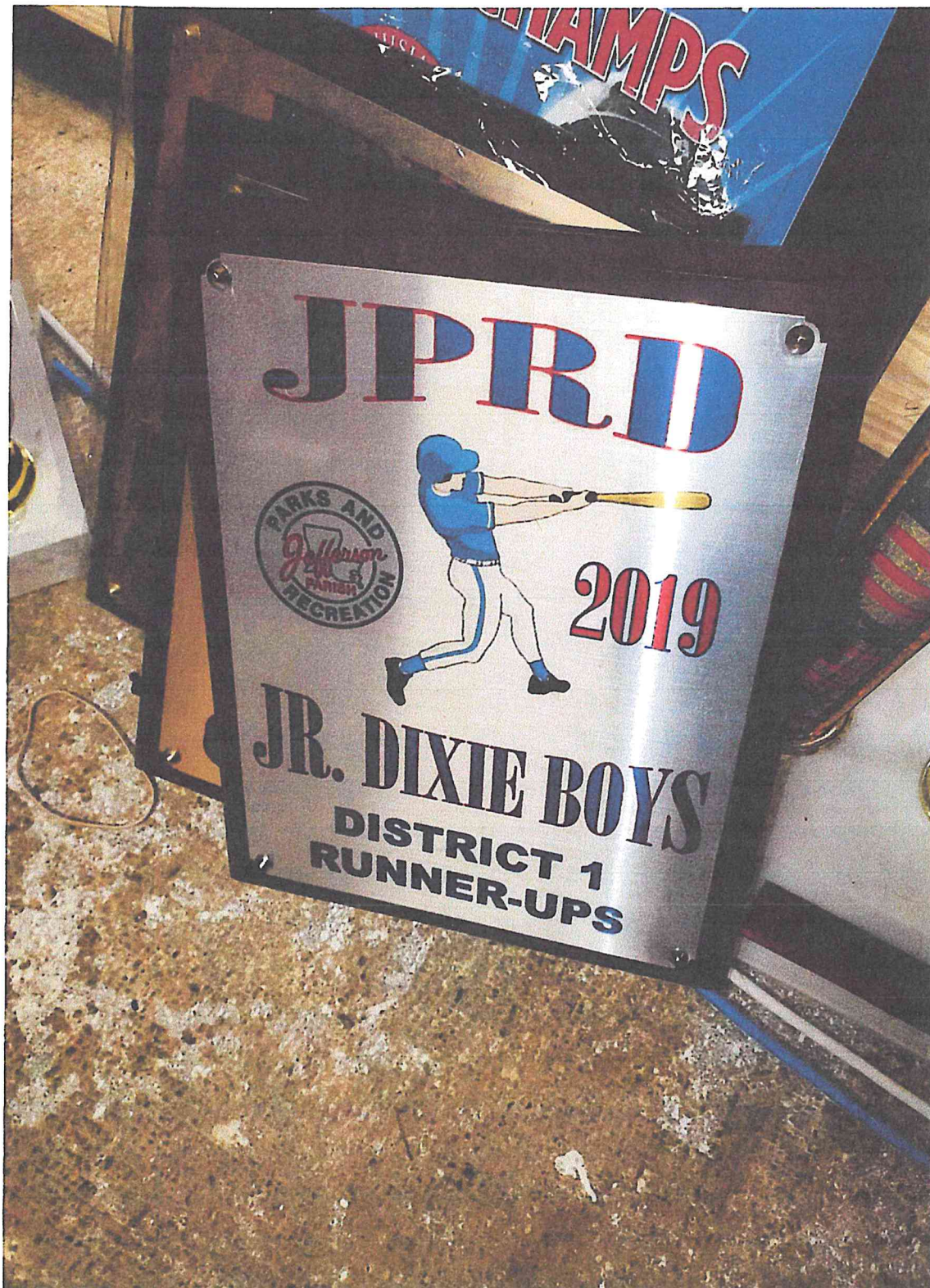
