



## General

**\*\*Bid Opening is postponed to March 17, 2015\*\***

### Contractor Questions:

1. Please indicate which trench detail we are to use for both drainage and sewer bedding and backfill. The trench detail for drainage shall be governed by Sheet 23 of the drawings, as modified by this addendum. Soil bearing capacity has been established at 300 psf, and the corresponding thickness of bedding from the table shall be used. (Previously, the thickness was fixed at 24". This change results in increased bedding thickness.) The trench detail for sanitary sewer varies based on depth, as shown on Sheet 26. The correct trench section by depth is shown in the upper right corner of the sheet; and the applicable soil type has been boxed.
2. Trench notes refer to "in addition to timber sheeting, a trench box may be used as bracing". In the past, on Jefferson Parish jobs with drainage pipe to be installed, a trench box without wood sheeting was allowed and wood sheeting would only be required on sanitary sewer. For this project, can we just use a trench box, or do we have to sheet trench with wood as well? This issue has been addressed with modification to Sheet 23 in the Drawings section below.
3. The pay item for videoing sewer lines refers to "New Sewer Lines". Are we required to also video and clean the existing sewer lines within limits of construction? The pay item title was incorrect, and has been modified. This item only applies to existing pipes. This pay item does apply to new pipes, including proposed lined pipes. There shall be no direct payment for cleaning and video inspection of the existing sewer mains or service connections (before or after lining) which are proposed to be lined by the contractor. There shall be no direct payment for cleaning and video inspection of new installed sewer gravity mains or service connections.
4. Is this job tax exempt? No.
5. Please clarify that this is not a "scale" job in regards to labor rates. Davis-Bacon wage rates do not apply to this project.
6. Would you create a pay item to address the drain pipe that is to be filled with flowable fill? The drain pipe is now to be removed, and the cost is to be included in Pay Item 202(01), "REMOVAL OF STRUCTURES AND OBSTRUCTIONS".
7. Can the catch basins be precast? Yes; however, the Contractor shall be responsible if the use of precast structures results in conflict with adjacent subsurface utilities, or irregular geometry cannot be accommodated by the precast structure delivered. Approval of shop drawings by Engineer will not relieve Contractor of this responsibility.
8. Does the roadway paving mix need to be a 4000 psi in 3 days mix? No, see clarification in Construction Specifications section, item (14), changing pavement to Type B.
9. Please clarify if the concrete headwalls require wing walls. The plan view on sheets 8, 9, & 16 show wing walls 12" long on each side of the head wall but the headwall detail on sheet 29 does not show wing walls. Wing walls are not required. Ignore the wing wall detail on sheets 8, 9, and 16.
10. According to Page 12, 14, & 16 there should be Details for the Vertical Waterline Offset (12,14) or the removal and replacement (16) on page 16A. The copy uploaded to central bidding does not include these details on page 16A. Can you please confirm that all

necessary information is available. Sheet 16A shows enlarged plan views of the offsets for clarity. Construction details are per the Jefferson Parish Standard, on Sheet 25.

### **Construction Specifications and Contract Documents**

11. Replace the Important Notice to All Bidders—Bid Requirements, pages IN-1 to IN-2, with the new Notice, attached.
12. Replace the Louisiana Uniform Public Works Bid Form, pages BF-1 through BF-7, with the new form, attached.
13. Section 203:
  - a. Item 203(04), “NON-PLASTIC EMBANKMENT (SAND)” will be measured and paid only for undercut ordered by the Engineer, net section. The existing roadway base material is to be preserved and recompacted. Granular backfill material over subsurface piping or following structure removal is absorbed in those respective pay items. No separate payment will be made for excavation required for undercut ordered.
  - b. Add item 203(06), “MUCK REMOVAL”. This item shall consist of the removal of mixtures of soils and organic matter (below the normal bottom of trench excavation) not suitable for pipe foundation material and replacement with approved bedding material. ### III. PART 3: CONSTRUCTION LAYOUT

1. The Contractor will be responsible for establishing all lines and grades and staking out all "Sewer System" work on this project from controls provided in the construction documents. There shall be no separate payment for construction layout related to the "Sanitary Sewer System".
2. **Sewer house connection pre-construction "Connectivity Report":**

The purpose of this "**Connectivity Report**" is to investigate and summarize all sewer house connections, connectivity issues, prior to construction of any underground utilities. The term "Connectivity" shall mean the ability to connect a sewer house connection to existing or proposed sewer gravity mains in accordance with Jefferson Parish standard requirements and guidelines.

This report shall include two general sections:

- Elevations of the existing sewer house connections, at the property line, which are anticipated to have connectivity issues. These house connections may or may not be identified on plans.
  - This section shall be performed by the contractor.
- Resolutions to any connectivity problems.
  - This section is typically preformed as a joint venture between the contractor and the A/E.
  - The A/E shall be responsible for any required design change.
  - The contractor is ultimately responsible for making sure that the design or redesign actually works.

  - h. Delete Pay Item S-505, “Tie New Sewer Service Connection Pipe to an Existing Service Connection.”
19. Section S(1004): Topsoil and Sodding have been deleted as separate pay items, and will now be paid lump sum as part of Landscaping & Yard Restoration . Topsoil and sod are required at disrupted locations where a homeowner maintains a lawn.

## **Drawings**

### **General**

20. The requirement for wingwalls has been deleted from Sheets 8, 9, and 16. Outfall headwalls will be in accordance with the standard detail, without headwalls.

### **Sheet 2**

21. Note 23 identifies incorrect pay item numbers; however, the intent of the note remains valid, that temporary relocation of services is at not direct pay, and permanent work is measured for payment.

**Sheets 3-5**

22. The limits of concrete paving removal and replacement have been enlarged to include the full width of the street within limits of drain pipe installation. The quantities have been modified on the bid form, and a roadway centerline profile has been provided in tabular form, attached as Table 2.
23. The existing roadway base shall remain in place, and shall be recompact under pay item 601(01).
24. 26 ft. street typical sections shall be the tangent crown on the Jefferson Parish standard detail.

**Sheets 9-16**

25. Existing drain lines shall be removed, not abandoned. Abandonment in lieu of removal may be requested by the Contractor or ordered by the Engineer in specific instances, will be considered at possible conflicts with proposed construction, on a case-by-case basis, and will be at no added cost to the work.
26. The profile of the drain lines has been revised. No new drawing sheets have been issued; rather, a table of revised structure invert elevations has been produced and is attached as Table 1.
27. The limits of concrete paving removal and replacement have been enlarged to include the full width of the street within limits of drain pipe installation. The quantities have been modified on the bid form, and a roadway centerline profile has been provided in tabular form, attached as Table 2.
28. All driveway aprons between the existing sidewalk and new street paving are to be replaced.
29. Since the drain line profile has been raised, sewer house connections that must cross the drain to reach the existing gravity sewer main are now in conflict. A 6" diameter service line will be installed parallel to new drain line, on the alignment of the existing drain line, to collect the house connections. This new sewer service line will cross the drain line at planned drainage structures, or at new conflict boxes added by this addendum. The items required for this new line, and the location of those items, has been included in tabular form as Table 3. Depths will be established in the field.
30. Sheet 9: The 46 LF of 72" RCP is deleted, and replaced with 60" RCP.
31. Sheet 9: Structures required at STA 1+35 and 1+43 are deleted. See Table 1. Existing RCP shown to be removed between the canal and STA 1+43 is to remain.
32. Sheet 16: The 41 LF of 54" RCP is deleted, and replaced with 48" RCP.
33. Replace Jefferson Parish Standard Plans on Sheets 23 and 25, with the new standards attached.

**Sheet 17**

34. Smooth dowel diameters are modified from 1-1/4" to 1".

**Sheet 23**

35. Trench Excavation Requirements: The following language shall supersede any stipulations of the drawings or specifications that conflict.
  - a. The Contractor is responsible to design an excavation and shoring system, including any dewatering, for installation of drain pipe in accordance with the contract; and to prevent lateral movement of the trench walls, floor heave, damage to adjacent utilities or structures, or other adverse effect.

- b. A written excavation plan and trench construction drawing, both sealed by a professional engineer licensed in the State of Louisiana, shall be required. The plan shall represent the result of geotechnical and structural analysis, and show the complete and detailed methods of installation, sequence of operations, shoring details and dimensions, and place restrictions upon the Contractor's operations as necessary to ensure successful construction.
- c. Excavations over 6ft in depth: Driven sheeting shall be required, of material selected by the Contractor (steel, timber, etc.), provided the performance requirements herein are met. Contractor shall determine if sheeting may be left in place or extracted. If sheeting is extracted, flowable fill must be placed into the voids immediately upon removal; and the proposed method must be addressed in the excavation plan. No additional payment will be made for sheeting left in place. Flowable fill will be at no direct pay, and placed in accordance with the Louisiana Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges, Section 710.03; materials shall be in accordance with Table 710-1 (excavatable). Sliding trench box methods are prohibited.
- d. Excavations 6ft in depth and less: Per the excavation plan submitted by the Contractor, subject to the restrictions on Sheet 23.
- e. Dewatering is restricted to within the trench sheeting. The Contractor shall not draw down the ground water of the general area.
- f. Any settlement, heave, displacement, or other defect of the installed drain pipe shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. Damage, displacement, or disruption of adjacent structures or utilities shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.
