Company History

Lone Star Auctioneers has been conducting timed online auctions for eighteen (18) years and live auctions for thirty-six (36) years. The company was incorporated in Texas on June 18, 1984, as a licensed live auction company and immediately began pursuing the government surplus, abandoned and impounded market. Lone Star Auctioneers' first government contract was for the sale of the City of Fort Worth Police Auto Pound, and we have held this contract continually since.

We continued to provide full-service live, web-cast and online auctions to local, state, and federal government agencies selling virtually every type of commodity in cities around the U.S. Our gross auction sales exceed six hundred thirty-two million dollars (\$632,000,000) over 7,600 live auctions and over 330,000 online auctions grossing over \$270,000,000 primarily for government agencies and educational institutions.

With the advent of the COVID-19 pandemic, Lone Star transitioned its live auction contracts to online and now is conducting online auctions only. Lone Star maintains the capacity, staff and equipment to conduct live auctions as needed.

We are a certified HUB and Woman-Owned, woman-run small business. We are privately owned, financially very sound and are in good standing with the Louisiana Secretary of State and Louisiana Auctioneer Licensing Board, the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts and the Texas Secretary of State.

Lone Star is sufficiently large and well-staffed to handle the proposed online auction(s) having done timed online auctions continuously since 2003. The owners and management are committed to maintaining close oversight and providing a personal level of service for each of our clients. We have a well-trained, motivated and stable staff with little turnover.

Our corporate history includes numerous contracts with government agencies and commercial entities. Several of our current and most recent federal government contracts include the following:

- City of Fort Worth sequential contracts since 1985 to present for both Fort Worth Auto Pound abandoned vehicles and fleet vehicles and equipment.
- City of Dallas sequential contracts since 1995 to present servicing all departments. We offer photography, key service, preparation of the online auctions and prepare ASR's or titles for mailing for the City of Dallas Auto Pound and Fleet.
- City of Irving sequential contracts since 1989 to present servicing all departments. We offer towing, photography, key service, preparation of the online auctions and prepare ASR's or titles for mailing for the City of Irving Auto Pound and Fleet.
- City of Lewisville sequential contracts since 2006 to present servicing all departments including Fleet.
- Sequential contracts with United States Marshals Service Northern District of Texas from 1989 to 2017. Services for those contracts include the towing and hauling, secure indoor and outdoor storage in our facilities, maintenance and disposition of seized vehicles, tractor trailers and heavy equipment for the Dallas/Fort Worth, Lubbock and Amarillo areas. Under that contract we have provided live, live and online auctions. Total sales approach \$13.4 million for this USMS client. Our online auction sales exceeded \$1,554 million in less than two years.
- Identical vehicle services contracts with the Southern District of Texas (Houston/Galveston region and the Corpus Christi/Upper Valley region), the Western District of Texas (El Paso and Eastern New Mexico region), and the District of Arizona. These contracts required us to have secure warehouse and outdoor storage facilities and vehicle towing capacity in each location.
- Under these U. S. Marshals Service contracts, we towed with our own equipment or subcontracted to tow thousands of vehicles, truck tractors, farm equipment, motorcycles, exotic cars, farm equipment and other large items.
- Over the terms of these contracts, Lone Star maintained eleven owned (6) and leased (5) secure indoor and outdoor storage facilities with motion and video surveillance in Dallas, Fort Worth, Houston, Corpus Christi, El Paso and Tucson, AZ.
- We held the highly complex Texas Facilities Commission contract with the State of Texas continuously since 1988 to 2019. During that tenure, we sold 85 live and live/WebCast auctions, which have averaged over \$1,000,000 per auction and in online-only auctions which have totaled approximately \$19 million in the last ten years. We have sold a total over \$126,000,000 in state surplus vehicles, equipment, FF&E and miscellaneous items for the State of Texas in the past 26 years.

Other notable online auction experience includes auctions of:

- A statue of Robert E. Lee (\$1,438,500) in June 2019 and a police helicopter (\$1,385,000) for the City of Dallas
- Five ferry boats for the Texas Department of Transportation
- The residual non-realty assets from Reunion Arena, former home of the Dallas Mavericks (for the City of Dallas)
- The remaining non-realty assets from Texas Stadium, former home of the Dallas Cowboys (for the City of Irving)
- Over \$1,000,000 worth of fashion products (82 pallets) made with exotic animal skin, hide, fur, and shell which were imported illegally and seized by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.
- Unclaimed Property through current and recent contracts with the states of Alabama, Montana, West Virginia, Utah, Tennessee and Indiana along with previous contracts with the California State Controller's Office (\$9,230,000), Office, Texas and South Carolina.
- Continuing online auctions for the entire Texas A&M University system and
- Numerous online surplus auctions for cities, counties, regional agencies, universities and school districts around the U.S. through national purchasing cooperative contracts with TIPS, Omnia Partners, BuyBoard and Choice Partners.

Lone Star Auctioneers is driven by our own high standards. We have four licensed auctioneers on staff, two being the owners of Lone Star Auctioneers. Staff is more than capable of performing to the highest standards required by Jefferson Parish. We have one fulltime Spanish speaking employee available for all auction functions. We commit to the Parish the courteous, competent and friendly services of a dedicated staff to maximize revenues, maintain immaculate records and minimize problems from all our activities. Lone Star Auctioneers will make the designated key personnel available to perform the requirements of this contract throughout the life of this contract. We will recruit and train additional staff as needed.

Nine Lone Star employees have been thoroughly vetted and given CJIS (Criminal Justice Information System) clearance and personal ID pass cards for access to secure areas within the Dallas Police Department. All current Lone Star Auctioneers employees have undergone thorough background checks through the FBI, United States Marshals Service and the Dallas and Fort Worth Police Departments including the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) and the Texas Crime Information Center (TCIC). All future employees will undergo rigorous background checks prior to their employment and utilization under this and our other contracts.

Lone Star Auctioneers enjoys an excellent reputation among buyers and sellers for integrity, honesty, dedication and results. We have increased our clients' net revenue over prior contractors for both live and online auctions.

Questions and Answers:

Question:

The first bullet point under Section 6.0 references "Provide...transportation." What transportation might be required of the contractor under the contract and transportation of what, from where to where and performing what tasks?

Answer:

Any transportation needed for the vendor to attend meetings, visit Jefferson Parish facilities, etc. as it relates to performing all tasks and satisfy all responsibilities which are described in the bid specifications.

Question:

The first bullet point under Section 6.0 refers to "transportation." What transportation might required under this contract, and if so, for what assets and from and to what locations.

Answer:

Any transportation needed for the vendor to attend meetings, visit Jefferson Parish facilities, etc., as it relates to performing all tasks and satisfy all responsibilities which are described in the bid specifications.

Question:

Under the Comprehensive Automobile Liability, reference is made to "an automobile insurance declaration affidavit. Where might a proposer such an affidavit? Does Jefferson Parish have such an affidavit form or wording? If not, where might be obtained?

Answer: Comprehensive Automobile Liability insurance is required for this contract. The vendor awarded the contract will attend meetings on Parish property and visit Jefferson Parish facilities, etc. therefore, Comprehensive Automobile Liability insurance is required. Under Comprehensive Automobile Liability, company vehicles are referenced but if company vehicles will not be utilized for this contract, Comprehensive Automobile Liability insurance for personal vehicles must be submitted with bid.

- Provide and absorb all costs of securing a host facility to operate the web-based/on-line auction system.
- System for collecting and processing payments from bidders that meets Payment Card Industry (PCI) data security standards to ensure companies process store or transmit credit card information securely. Jefferson Parish will not collect, process or retain payment information of any kind.
- Provide training to Jefferson Parish staff as needed.
- System for setting reserve pricing (minimum price) on items.
- Auctioneer agrees to accept electronic payments, cash, or wire transfers.

Section 6.0 – Specifications: FULLY FUNCTIONAL DIGITAL CLOUD BASED/ON-LINE AUCTIONEERING SERVICES

- All bid award payments must be collected by the auctioneer firm within three (3) days of the close of each auction.
- All maintenance, upgrades and security patches to the hardware, software, servers, peripherals, etc. for the length of the contract.
- All support and maintenance shall be available via email, on-line and by telephone as needed to operate the auction site throughout the contract.
- Immediate notification of any cyber incident that could impact this service, including the data collected on behalf of the Parish.
- Maintenance and support shall be available Monday-Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. central standard time.
- Simple and uniform methods for bidders to submit bids and have the highest bid price to date posted on the bidding site for all bidders to view.
- Provide Jefferson Parish fair market value/cost of all items before items are placed out for bidding.
- Displaying date and time the bid will end.
- Internal method of recording all bids, identifying the winning bidder, and the second highest bidder.
- Internal method of processing complaints or disputes for bidding and payments.
- Jefferson Parish will not pay for freight or shipping on any items sold.
- Winning bidder of each item will have seven (7) working days to retrieve their items.
- After the seventh (7th) day the item becomes property of Jefferson Parish and the bidder relinquishes all rights and payments of the item.
- Jefferson Parish will not pay for any title transfer charges.
- All items will be sold as is where is.
- Appropriate staff to perform successful on-line auctions.
- Responsible for the collection of payment of all items sold.
- At the 1st of each month, provide a "monthly report" in Microsoft Excel containing the following information:
 - Description of each item sold.
 - Price of each item sold.
 - Date of each item sold.
 - Reserve price of each item sold.
 - Plus, or minus of awarded bid price for each item sold compared to the reserve cost.
 - Date each item sold was placed out for auction.
 - Duration of time each item was placed out for auction.
 - Second highest bid on each item.
 - Name and country of origin on winning bidder and second highest bidder for each item.
 - Description and length of time each un-sold item has been listed on the auction site.
 - Total amount of all awarded bids for the month.
 - Total amount of all items still out for auction.
- Jefferson Parish shall set the final reserve pricing (minimum price) on all items.
- A Microsoft Excel spreadsheet (collection tool) for loading assets to the web site.
- Recommendations on items that have not sold after 60 days.

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Question:

Is there any real estate planned to be auctioned off in the future?

Answer: Real Estate will not be auctioned in this bid.

Question:

From discussion at the pre-bid meeting, it is our understanding that respondents are discouraged from providing narrative content in addition to the RFB's required documentation. Without prospective vendors providing insight into their respective platforms, service, and best practices, how does Jefferson Parish plan to vet responses to ensure respondents are in fact in compliance with the Parish's required specifications? Does the Parish intend to hold interviews or request proof of compliance during the stated 45-day evaluation window?

Answer:

Vendor shall meet all requirements as described in the bid specifications. If at any time during the contract the vendor fails to provide scope, deliverables, etc., Jefferson Parish will cancel the contract.

REVISIONS:

The revisions to the specifications are indicated in red.

Section 6.0 – Specifications: FULLY FUNCTIONAL DIGITAL CLOUD BASED/ON-LINE AUCTIONEERING SERVICES

Auctioneering Company shall supply/provide the following:

- Provide all labor, materials, equipment, transportation, computer hardware, software, programing, written literature, peripherals, servers and all other products and information required to provide a fully functional digital cloud based/on-line auctioneering service to allow for the sale of various types of vehicles, equipment, office furniture, sporting goods, computers and other miscellaneous Jefferson Parish owned property.
- 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year on-line bidding.
- System shall be capable of adding, withdrawing, and cancelling auctions without penalty to Jefferson Parish.
- Security system, anti-virus, and firewalls capable of preventing hacking of auction information.
- The vendor shall operate its own proprietary auction platform for this contract.
- Jefferson Parish will not pay for any cost associated for chargebacks and buyer fraud that may occur. The vendor must accept responsibility for chargebacks and buyer fraud that may occur.
- A technical resource to support the Parish will all aspects of the platform. This includes troubleshooting and general support of the platform. Vendor and Parish will agree upon reason Service Level Agreement (Time it takes a vendor to resolve a trouble ticket) for outages and trouble ticket resolution.
- Any data requested by the Parish in a readable format. Vendor will securely retain data on behalf of the Parish in accordance with Parish retention policies.
- Standard Operating Procedures to include but not limited to the following:
 - Recovery of lost data
 - Security breaches
 - System failure
- On Site and on-line training and support of Jefferson Parish employees throughout the contract for the operation and maintenance of the services.
- Website shall be capable of loading and removing auction items at any time which best suits the needs of Jefferson Parish.
- Monthly detailed financial and summary reports of all transaction to Jefferson Parish.

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Section 6.0 – Specifications: FULLY FUNCTIONAL DIGITAL CLOUD BASED/ON-LINE AUCTIONEERING SERVICES

Continued:

- Instructions and assistance on how to perform the following:
 - Insert descriptions and photographs of items on the site.
 - Payments from bidders are accepted.
 - Jefferson Parish will receive payments.
 - Items will be picked up from Jefferson Parish.

Section 6.1- Promotion and Advertising:

Auctioneering company shall perform and/or provide the following:

- Auctioneering firm shall provide monthly advertising of the availability of all items being auctioned at a minimum of once a month.
- All advertising shall be able to attract a minimum of fifty-thousand viewers at any time.
- For items valued at \$4,000.00 or greater the successful bidder shall provide a marketing team to contact potential bidders who has shown expressed interest in specific items.
- Throughout the duration of the contract, the vendor must demonstrate its ability to drive higher auction sales results. The vendor shall use marketing plans, website traffic statistics, and recent sale comparison data. Vendor shall provide a monthly report (due on the 15th on each month) which details all efforts made.



Price Must Include the Cost of Naming Jefferson Parish as Additional Insured:

Bidder acknowledges that Bidder recovered the cost of any required insurance in the contract price as required by La.R.S. 9:2780.1 and that Bidder recovered any such cost for the purposes of insuring an obligation to indemnify Jefferson Parish, defend Jefferson Parish, or hold Jefferson Parish harmless and that Bidder's indemnity liability is limited to the amount of the proceeds that are payable under the insurance policy or policies that Bidder has obtained.

Electronic Procurement: Beginning November 1, 2020, Jefferson Parish will no longer accept manual bid submissions; and will only accept bid submissions electronically via our e-Procurement system, Central Bidding. Central Bidding can be accessed by visiting either www.centralbidding.com or www.jeffparishbids.net. All bidders will be required to register with Central Bidding. Probable Construction Cost: Per Jefferson Parish Administrative Policy, the probable construction cost is not revealed in the Jefferson Parish Bidding Documents. Section 2.0- Scope:

We extend this bid for the successful vendor to provide all labor, materials, equipment, transportation, computer hardware, software, programming, written literature, and servers needed to provide the following services for the Jefferson Parish Department of General Services Surplus Property Division:

- Two (2) year contract to provide a fully functional digital cloud based/on-line auctioneering services for the sale of vehicles, equipment, office furniture, sporting goods, computers and other miscellaneous items.

NOTE: Items to be sold does not include real estate or land parcel under this scope and contract.

Lone Star Auctioneers has been granted a Louisiana Auction Business License #AB-524. Please see the attached Letter of Authority and proof of Business and Individual licensure from the LALB. (Attachment 4)

In the event that Jefferson Parish had an asset or assets that the Parish deemed would be better sold in a live auction venue, Lone Star Auctioneers has three staff auctioneers who maintain current Reciprocal Louisiana Auctioneer licenses as requested in this solicitation. Those license numbers are Marilyn Burgess #1361, Ed Lanford #1369, and Sim Burgess #1755. The LALB informs us that physical paper licenses are no longer being issued, and that licenses can be verified on the LALB website.

Please see three attached "proof of licensure" letter for three company auctioneers from the Louisiana Office of the Governor Auctioneers Licensing Board qualifying us under this section of the solicitation. We do however have copies of our current Louisiana licenses and include them in the attachment.

Section 5.0- Quantities:

There shall be no guaranty on the quantity of items sold throughout the twenty-four-month duration of the contract.

Section 6.0- Specifications: FULLY FUNCTIONAL DIGITAL CLOUD BASED/ON-LINE AUCTIONEERING SERVICES
Auctioneering Company shall supply/provide the following:

- Provide all labor, materials, equipment, transportation, computer hardware, software, programing, written literature, peripherals, servers and all other products and information required to provide a fully functional digital cloud based/on-line auctioneering service to allow for the sale of various types of vehicles, equipment, office furniture, sporting goods, computers and other miscellaneous Jefferson Parish owned property.

Lone Star is currently supplying and has supplied these exact services to government agencies and entities without fail or fault since August 2003. Since that date, Lone Star has sold over \$33,665,000.00 in timed online auctions since launching our website.

Lone Star will provide all of the above and any related requirements. Jefferson Parish will need to have access to the internet and the ability to provide Lone Star with .csv compatible files of description details and merchandise images in .jpg format.

There will be no need for the Parish to provide any software or hardware to participate in online auctions on Lone Star Auctioneers' website. Lone Star will furnish all hardware and software for the duration of the contract.

- 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year on-line bidding.

Lone Star online auction software has operated continuously around the clock since 2003. There has been zero downtime or interruption in any online auction since launching the new online platform on July 1, 2020. Lone Star's previous software provided us with 99.995% uptime over the course of its operation from August 2003 to July 2020.

All systems are thoroughly password protected, and only authorized Lone Star and Designated Parish personnel will be provided password-protected access to the Parish account to view and retrieve current and historical data in real time.

Lone Star Auctioneers and our software design and hosting provider each maintain backup hardware, software, data trunks, cloud storage and devices. All are protected by multiple Uninterruptable Power Supply (UPS) battery backup systems.

- A technical resource to support the Parish will all aspects of the platform. This includes troubleshooting and general support of the platform. Vendor and Parish will agree upon reason Service Level Agreement (Time it takes a vendor to resolve a trouble ticket) for outages and trouble ticket resolution.

Jefferson Parish will be assigned a primary technical support contact and a secondary support contact to provide support as described above.

- Any data requested by the Parish in a readable format. Vendor will securely retain data on behalf of the Parish in accordance with Parish retention policies.

Lone Star Auctioneers will comply.

- Standard Operating Procedures to include but not limited to the following:
 - Recovery of lost data
 - Security breaches
 - System failure

Lone Star Auctioneers will comply.

- On Site and on-line training and support of Jefferson Parish employees throughout the contract for the operation and maintenance of the services.

Lone Star Auctioneers can and does routinely provide all necessary training, support and operational services at startup, throughout the duration of the contract and when requested. Jefferson Parish will be provided initial intuitive training aids and a simple "How To" guide for performing the functions of lot preparation, photography and data transmission. - Website shall be capable of loading and removing auction items at any time, which best suits the needs of Jefferson Parish.

Affirmed.

- Monthly detailed financial and summary reports of all transaction to Jefferson Parish.

Lone Star will furnish these reports to designated Parish personnel upon completion of each auction and monthly as requested.

- Provide and absorb all costs of securing a host facility to operate the digital cloud based/on-line auction system.

Affirmed.

- System for collecting and processing payments from bidders that meets Payment Card Industry (PCI) data security standards to ensure companies process store or transmit credit card information securely. Jefferson Parish will not collect, process or retain payment information of any kind.

Lone Star's electronic invoices contain a "Pay/View" invoice link to Authorize.net for payment by most major credit cards. Buyers will NOT be charged a fee for credit card usage. This makes the payment process easy, smooth and fast. Buyers invoices immediately become "Paid Receipts" for presentation at checkout and retrieval of the buyer's purchases. Sellers can view the status of payments in their account on Lone Star's website.

All bid award payments will be collected by the auctioneer firm within three (3) days of the close of each auction.

- Simple and uniform methods for bidders to submit bids and have the highest bid price to date posted on the bidding site for all bidders to view.

A visit to LSO.CC will aptly demonstrate how simple and intuitive Lone Star Auctioneers's online auctions are.

- Provide Jefferson Parish fair market value/cost of all items before items are placed out for bidding.

This valuation will be used as a start price to encourage bidding.

- Displaying date and time the bid will end.

Is prominently displayed on every lot.

- Internal method of recording all bids, identifying the winning bidder, and the second highest bidder.

Affirmed. This is a standard feature of the site.

- Internal method of processing complaints or disputes for bidding and payments.

- A Microsoft Excel spreadsheet (collection tool) for loading assets to the website.

Affirmed.

- Recommendations on items that have not sold after 60 days.

Affirmed. Such items can be grouped into larger lots to encourage bidding and sale of unsold assets.

- Instructions and assistance on how to perform the following:
 - Insert descriptions and photographs of items on the site. (Included in the "How To" packet provided to Parish staff.
 - Payments from bidders are accepted. Lone Star accepts credit cards, wire transfers, bank or postal money orders and cash. A credit card link is imbedded on each buyer's invoice through which the bidder can pay through Authorize.net.

We will purchase Google AdWords for items of significant value to draw traffic from searches for specific items such as "firetrucks," "draglines," "excavators," etc. as needed.

Lone Star will advertise in local and state-wide print publications at the initiation of and throughout the contract as merchandise warrants.

- All advertising shall be able to attract a minimum of fifty-thousand viewers at any time.

In the month of November 2020, our sites drew over 2.3 million page views which is typical for our sites.

- For items valued at \$4,000.00 or greater the successful bidder shall provide a marketing team to contact potential bidders who has shown expressed interest in specific items.

Lone Star does this on a frequent and regular basis and will for Jefferson Parish.

Section 7.0-Manner of Payment to Jefferson Parish:
