JEFFERSON PARISH AGENCIES AND MUNICIPALITIES**

SCOPE OF CONTRACT:

This one-year contract will be for the furnishing of general parts, accessories and supplies for all parish vehicles and motorized equipment, including dealer-type vehicles parts, accessories, supplies and automotive chemicals/agents, typically and routinely used by the Department of Central Garage in the repair and maintenance of parish motorized vehicles, and shall be utilized on an as-needed basis. All Jefferson Parish Agencies and Municipalities may use this contract.

This contract shall be subject to the Jefferson Parish Resolution 113646 which shall be considered part of the bid and ensuing contract. A copy of Resolution 113646 may be obtained from the Office of the Parish Clerk, 6th Floor, General Government Building, 200 Derbigny Street, Gretna, Louisiana, 70053.

Parish reserves the right to award a lump sum bid to the highest percentage overall responsive and responsible bidder based on the discount percentage(s) offered off of manufacturer's price list(s).

Contractor shall maintain adequate stock/inventory, and distribution channels necessary to deliver required parts within two (2) hours after order placement, to either East bank or West bank locations.

Bidders shall state brand and part numbers, if bidding other than as specified. "Cost-plus" pricing is prohibited and shall cause the bid to be rejected. Price list must be submitted with bid submission. Failure to do so will result in bid being rejected.

NOTE: If specified brands and parts cannot be cross referenced to the bidder's price list, bidder shall notify the Department of Purchasing prior to bid opening, that the part cannot be bid, along with a written reason. If it is determined that a part number is erroneous, Purchasing will issue an addendum with corrected part numbers.

Bid Surety:

Bidder shall submit a bid surety in the amount of \$5,000.00, with bid submission. Failure to do so will result in bid rejection.

Quantities:

All quantities and items included herein are for purposes of bid comparison only.

Payments will be based on actual quantities and items as authorized by the Department Director.

Parts Guarantees:

All customary guaranties for replacement of defective parts furnished by Contractor by manufacturers or other dealers shall be furnished to the Parish when the parts are sold to the Parish.

Hours of Operation:

Normal working hours for all parts related personnel are from 7:00AM to 3:30PM Monday through Friday, except Holidays.

Expedited Parts:

In the event the user agency requires and authorized any expedited means of delivery, the vendor may be reimbursed for the express freight charges. Express freight charges shall be prepaid and added to the invoice, and must be substantiated with a copy of the shipper's invoice and freight bill for payment. **NOTE: All express deliveries will need prior approval from Fleet Director or his designee.**

Liability:

Refer to Resolution No. 113646.

Price Lists:

A copy of each current manufacturer's price sheet will be maintained and up-to-date for ready reference. Additional new price lists required for representative coverage for the fleet of vehicles and equipment will be submitted to the Department Director, in duplicate for incorporation into contract. Superseded or revised price lists which increase or decrease the price of any parts, accessories, or supplies, will be submitted to Department Director for approval or rejection. Approved superseded or revised price lists will be processed as above. Rejected price lists will be returned with reasons for rejection within five (5) working days after receipt. Contractor shall notify the Department Director of impending cost increases prior to their effective date.

Warranty:

In addition to any rights granted under the Contract, Contractor agrees to convey to Department, the same warranty against defective parts he receives from his supplier, with full and general warranty of title and full subrogation to all rights and actions of warranty and other rights as held therein by Contractor.

Price List Coverage for Common Parts, Accessories and Supplies:

If it is determined, at any time during the life of this contract, that Contractor has not furnished sufficient price lists to cover at least one (1) product line of all common parts, accessories, and supplies, Contractor will be notified in writing by the Department Director which product lines have not been covered. Within fifteen (15) calendar days after such notification, Contractor will furnish sufficient price lists to provide required coverage. If the additional required price lists are not furnished within fifteen (15) calendar days, the Department will have the option to secure such price lists and

incorporate them in the contract as a basis for pricing common parts, accessories and supplies.

Materials and Equipment:

Whenever a material, article or piece of equipment, is identified in specifications by reference to manufacturer or vendor names, trade names, catalog numbers, it is so identified for the purpose of establishing a standard. Any material, article, or piece of equipment of another manufacturer or vendor which will perform adequately the duties imposed by the general design will be considered equally acceptable provided the material, article, or piece of equipment so proposed by Contractor is, in the opinion of Department Director of equal substance, appearance and function. When a material, article or piece of equipment is to be specified or called for, it is intended and shall be understood that the proposal tendered by Contractor includes those products in this bid. Should the Contractor desire to provide an equal to those specified, Contractor shall so indicate on the bid forms and provide manufactured price list on all quoted with bid submission.

By submitting a bid, vendor acknowledges this and will abide by all provisions of the referenced Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS AND GENERAL CONDITIONS

THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS APPLY

All bids submitted are subject to these instructions and general conditions resolution number 113646 and/or 113647 and any special conditions and specifications contained herein, all of which are made part of this bid proposal reference. By submitting a bid, vendor agrees to comply with all provisions of Louisiana Law as well be in compliance with Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances, Louisiana Code of Ethics, applicable Jefferson Parish ethical standards and Jefferson Parish Resolution number 113646 and/or Resolution no. 113647.

Jefferson Parish requires all products to be new (current) and all work must be performed according to standard practices for the project. Unless otherwise specified, no aftermarket parts will be accepted. Unless otherwise specified, all workmanship and materials must have at least one (1) year guaranty, in writing from the date of delivery and/or acceptance of the project. Any deviations or alterations from the specifications must be indicated and/or supporting documentation supplied with bid submission.

Bidders should submit all questions in writing and fax them to (504) 364-2693 no later than FIVE (5) working days prior to bid opening. Bid numbers should be mentioned on all requests. Questions may also be emailed to the buyer for this bid at the email address listed above. If submitting on-line, vendors may send questions via the E-Procurement site no later than five (5) working days prior to the bid opening.

JEFFERSON PARISH WILL ACCEPT ONE BID ONLY FROM EACH VENDOR. Items bid must meet specifications.

JEFFERSON PARISH will accept one price for each item unless otherwise indicated. Two or more prices for one item will result in bid rejection.

Quantities listed are for bidding purposes only. Actual requirements may be more or less than quantities listed.

All formal Addenda require written acknowledgement on the bid form by the bidder. Failure to acknowledge an Addendum on the bid form shall cause the bid to be rejected. Jefferson Parish reserves the right to award bid to the next responsible and responsive bidder in this event.

If the bid exceeds \$30,000.00 and the company is duly authorized to do business in the state of Louisiana, a corporate resolution **must** be submitted with the bid or the person signing the bid documents must be listed on the Louisiana Secretary of State's website as an officer of the corporation, unless bidder has otherwise complied with LSA-R. 38:2212(A)(1)(C) or LSA-R.S. 38:2212 (O). If the bid is in excess of \$30,000 and bidder is registered out of the state of Louisiana, a corporate resolution must be submitted with the bid, unless bidder has otherwise complied with LSA-R.S. 38:2212(A)(1)(C) or LSA-R.S. 38:2212 (O). Failure to comply will cause bid to be rejected; the Parish reserves the right to award bid to the next responsive bidder in this event.

- A. AWARD OF CONTRACT: JEFFERSON PARISH reserves the right to award contracts or place orders on a lump sum or individual item basis, or such combination, as shall in its judgment be in the best interest of JEFFERSON PARISH. **This contract will be awarded to the highest percentage off of list price averaged by all manufacturers or awarded per line item to the highest percentage off of list price.**

All bid percentage off of list price shall remain valid for 45 days. Jefferson Parish and the selected vendor by mutual written consent may mutually agree to extend the deadline for award by one (1) or more extensions of thirty (30) calendar days.

Preference is hereby given to materials, supplies, and provisions produced, manufactured or grown in Louisiana, quality being equal to articles offered by competitors outside the state. "LSA-R.S.38:2251-2261"

- B. CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT: JEFFERSON PARISH reserves the right to cancel any contract at any time and for any reason by issuing a THIRTY (30) day written notice to the contractor.
- C. PRICES: Jefferson Parish is exempt from paying sales tax under LSA-R.S. 47:301 (8)(C). All prices for purchases by Jefferson Parish for supplies and materials shall be quoted in the unit of measure specified and unless otherwise specified, shall be exclusive of state and parish taxes.

For good cause and as consideration for executing a contract with Jefferson Parish, vendor conveys, sells, assigns and transfers to Jefferson Parish or its assigns all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of Louisiana, relating to the particular good or services purchased or acquired by Jefferson Parish.

Quantities listed are for bidding purposes only. Actual requirements may be more or less than quantities listed.

Bidders are not to exclude from participation in, deny the benefits or, or subject to discrimination under any program or activity, any person in the United States on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex; nor discriminate on the basis of age under the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, or with respect to an otherwise qualified handicapped individual as provided in Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, or on the basis of religion except that any exemption from such prohibition against discrimination on the basis of religion as provided in the Civil Rights Act of 1964, or Title VI and VII of the Act of April 11, 1968, shall also apply. This assurance includes compliance with the administrative requirements of the Revenue Sharing final handicapped discrimination provisions contained in Section 51.55 (c), (d), (e), and (k)(5) of the Regulations. 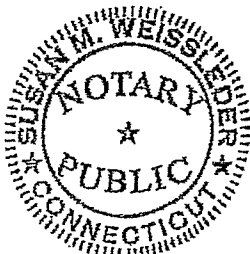

Section references are to the Internal Revenue Code unless otherwise noted.

Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

- Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued),
- Certify that you are not subject to backup withholding, or
- Claim exemption from backup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee. If applicable, you are also certifying that as a U.S. person, your allocable share of any partnership income from a U.S. trade or business is not subject to the withholding tax on foreign partners' share of effectively connected income.

Note. If a requester gives you a form other than Form W-9 to request your TIN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

Definition of a U.S. person. For federal tax purposes, you are considered a U.S. person if you are:

- An individual who is a U.S. citizen or U.S. resident alien,
- A partnership, corporation, company, or association created or organized in the United States or under the laws of the United States,
- An estate (other than a foreign estate), or
- A domestic trust (as defined in Regulations section 301.7701-7).

Special rules for partnerships. Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax on any foreign partners' share of income from such business. Further, in certain cases where a Form W-9 has not been received, a partnership is required to presume that a partner is a foreign person, and pay the withholding tax. Therefore, if you are a U.S. person that is a partner in a partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States, provide Form W-9 to the partnership to establish your U.S. status and avoid withholding on your share of partnership income.

The person who gives Form W-9 to the partnership for purposes of establishing its U.S. status and avoiding withholding on its allocable share of net income from the partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States is in the following cases:

- The U.S. owner of a disregarded entity and not the entity,
