As advertised, sealed bids will be received until the hour of 2:00 p.m., local time on Thursday, May 26, 2016 in the Purchasing Department, Suite 4400, Jefferson Parish General Government Building, located at 200 Derbigny Street, Gretna, Louisiana, 70053, and publicly opened upon completion of administrative tasks for the above referenced project.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

This addendum, as issued by the Architect, shall become part of the Contract Documents dated January 29, 2016 for the above referenced project. Contractors must acknowledge all addenda in the appropriate place on the bid form, and failure to do so will result in the rejection of their bid. Contractors bidding this project shall be cognizant of all items contained herein, submit their bid accordingly, and be responsible for notifying his subcontractors of the contents of this addendum. The proposed Contract Documents for this work are modified as follows:

GENERAL ITEMS

MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE:

A Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference was held on May 12, 2016 at 10:00 A.M. at the Jefferson Parish Juvenile Justice Center (1546 Gretna Blvd., Harvey, LA 70058). Sign-in sheet (2 pages, starting with Page 3) is enclosed herein.

1. Jefferson Parish Purchasing Dept. Representative passed sign-in sheet and discussed bid requirements.
2. Attendees made introductions.
3. Bids are due by 2:00pm on Thursday, May 26, 2016. See Project Manual for further bid requirements.
4. Architect reiterated deadlines per Divisions 0 and 1 of the Project Manual and public bid law.
5. All questions and clarifications must be submitted in writing and directed to Steve Graves and Annie Labruzzo (email addresses were given during the meeting).
6. Both starting with the Notice to Proceed date, Substantial Completion shall be within 240 calendar days, and Final Acceptance shall be within 285 calendar days. Liquidated damages will be charged at \$500.00 per day.
7. An overview of the project scope of work and restrictions for construction were provided, including specific substrate preparation requirements in areas to receive new carpet.
8. Facility core hours are from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm, and it will remain in operation during construction. Work areas shall be strategically scheduled for limited time periods to minimize disruption. Safety and well being of staff and clients is of utmost importance.
9. This is a secure facility. Owner must review and approve anyone requesting an access badge to the site.
10. Contractor must provide a fulltime superintendent on site to monitor work at all times.
11. After hours work may be scheduled with Owner, who will provide security detail for those hours. Bidders are advised to refer to www.jpjc.org for a list of court holidays when work may also be allowed.
12. All deliveries shall be coordinated with Owner prior to arrival date, and Owner will not sign receipt forms. See Section 01040 in the Project Manual for guidelines for working in an occupied building.
13. A fenced exterior area is available on-site for staging and storage. Contractor must provide their own lockable containers (i.e. pods) and is responsible for security of all materials. Strict tool control will be enforced.
14. A construction trailer and temporary power pole are required per Section 01040 of the Project Manual.

15. Contractor will be provided with a limited number of reserved parking spaces on-site.
16. All utility work and interruption must occur outside of operating hours and be coordinated a minimum of one week beforehand with the Owner. Work shall not interrupt facility operations.
17. All work in courtrooms must be coordinated with Owner 1-2 weeks in advance.
18. To schedule a site visit, contact Damon Anderson at (504) 367-3500 x850 with 24 hours notice.
19. Official changes to contract documents will be made by addenda only.
20. Meeting closed with site tour following.

CLARIFICATIONS:

1. Concerning the maximum turnaround times described in the PHASING AND SCHEDULING NOTES shown on the drawing cover sheet, "days" shall be defined as consecutive business days, excluding weekends and holidays. With deliberate and careful scheduling, this could result in additional construction time within the space by incorporating the weekends directly before, during, and/or after the limited number of business days.
2. For the purposes of calculating builder's risk insurance for this project, the building value is \$5.5 million.


