CLARIFICATIONS AND EXCEPTIONS ATTACHED

Due to material shortages, and material and transportation cost increases, the modular manufacturers and the freight companies may experience delays and increases. Such delays and increases will be passed on to the customer which are unavoidable at this time. Prompt notification and communication will be provided.

A Quick Buildings Modular representative will want to visit the site upon the acceptance of a proposal and prior to signing a contract.

“Installation” means to set each modular unit on the site pad, lag the units together, build all dry-stacked piers at 4’ height and anchor per the foundation plan, bond the dry-stacked piers with cement (if required), dry-in the roof and seam the exterior sides at mate lines. The interior finish at mate lines is included; finish the walls, floor, and ceiling at each mate line. Should you not follow foundation plan, a variance may be required.

- Customer must check with the local authority having jurisdiction to make sure that all local codes are met in the proposal. Quick Buildings cannot be responsible for knowing all local codes. Modular manufacturers build to State code, only.
- Customer is responsible for any additional construction, material or services that is not included in the Quick Buildings’ proposal, sales contract, or drawings. In the state of Louisiana, customers are required to have an Architect for each project. Should the City/State require an architect for this project, the cost for this service would be by customer. In the State of Alabama, should Division of Construction Management (DCM) approvals be required for your project, the Buyer/Owner is responsible for hiring a design professional to provide all submittals o DCM
- Quick Buildings shall provide the State and 3rd party approved floor plans and “typical” foundation plans. They will be stamped by either an engineer or architect.
- If the foundation requires additional drawings due to local codes or requirements, especially if the site is in a flood zone, the customer will be responsible for additional engineering fees and any additional materials and labor to install the modular.
- Customer or their general contractor shall be responsible for all site development, including but not limited to, soil conditions and poured concrete for the foundation, if required. The site pad must be free of vegetation and be well compacted. The pad shall not allow stormwater to flow or pond under the building. Quick Buildings can quote this work at the site visit if you wish for Quick Buildings to provide these services.
- Utility connections, including plumbing and electrical manifolding between units/modules of the building is by others. Quick Buildings can offer these services and quote for these services after a site visit.
- Junction boxes are empty, yet have ¾” conduit and pull strings to “fish” wire through for special systems. The wiring is by others.
- Quick Buildings shall provide the manufacturer’s stock colors only. Any non-stock colors may result in an upcharge.
- Customer shall notify Quick Buildings with a Notice to Proceed for fabrication. The building shall be delivered upon completion at the factory.

- The customer shall be responsible for access from the main road, street, or highway to the site pad for delivery; including but not limited to tree limbs, power lines, road, and site conditions.
 - A Quick Buildings representative will take delivery of the units at the site, inspect the units and sign the bill of lading. Quick Buildings may use subcontractors for some services and those services will be coordinated/managed by a Quick Buildings representative. Should your project require an onsite Project Manager, a quote can be provided for said service.
 - The customer may be charged 2% of the building cost for any delay of delivery caused by the customer or general contractor (i.e. the site not being ready, permits not secured, etc.). This fee is to cover the costs of storing the building upon completion of fabrication.
 - The tires and axles shall be removed and will remain property of Quick Buildings.
 - The hitches will be stored under the building or stored by customer.
 - Exterior doors and entrances must be protected from outdoor elements, the use of an awning or other protective measures are required to maintain the manufacturer's warranty.
 - Awnings, signage, steps, and ramps, by others, unless quoted on the Proposal. Awning proposed on quote will have a 40" projection 50" wide all aluminum. Steps/Ramp proposed on quote will be aluminum with 48" elevation 5'4" X5'4" landing and 4'X24" Ramp system with 5'4" X10'8" turn back landing with another 4'X24' ADA ramp system, (1) 5'X5' landing 48" elevation universal stair system for second door.
 - Site waste container and portable toilet will be by others unless quoted above.

 - The manufacturer's warranty is for 12 months following the manufacturer's date of completion, any delay in delivery will not extend the warranty. Some components and materials in the building may have extended warranties.
 - The installation warranty by Quick Buildings is for one full year from the completion of the tie downs.
 - Regarding any warranty service calls: the customer must notify Quick Buildings in a timely fashion, by phone, email or writing of any problems that require attention. The lack of a timely notice could incur additional damages and the cost of said repairs shall be the responsibility of the customer.
 - Quick Buildings shall provide the customer and their general contractor a certificate of general liability and workman's compensation insurance.
Payment Terms: 30% deposit, 60% when all modular units arrive at the site and 10% due upon completion.
 - Taxes are not quoted on the proposal. Quick Buildings will collect the sales/use tax and remit to the appropriate jurisdiction, unless a certificate of exemption or direct pay permit is provided.
- Removal of (1) 16X56 is contingent upon the road worthiness of the modular. Should it not be road worthy to remove and dispose of by way of transportation and if found to need to be torn down and material disposed of in a dumpster, cost would be additional.
