Measurement and Payment

In reference to Paragraph 3 on Page 2:

Payment for these services will be measured per Lump Sum (once per year) and shall cover the annual services (inspections/testing) specified in Tables I & II, Exhibits "A" & "B" for Fire Engines. Major service maintenance to each Engine shall include all labor, equipment and materials and incidentals necessary to accomplish the work. Also included under this bid item is the following:

- ~~Replacement of all batteries as need be.~~
- Filters -- (Replace oil, fuel and air filters) at all major annual services.
- Oil -- (Replace at all major annual services)
- Lubricants -- (Replace as need be)
- Antifreeze -- (Replace at all major annual services)
- ~~Belts -- (Replace as need be.)~~
- ~~Spark Plugs -- Replace in the first Major (annual) services only.~~
- ~~Hoses -- (Replace as need be).~~

Exception: Siddons Martin Emergency Group has a diverse supply of batteries, belts, spark plugs, and hoses, and cannot accurately price them appropriately to be included within the Major service maintenance. Any items not included will be replaced on an as needed basis at a mark-up of 1.67% over supplier cost..

Replacement of Parts in General

In reference to Paragraph 2 on Page 5:

Payment for replacement of parts (other than specified in this contract) to complete any necessary required repairs on Fire Trucks that is not covered under this contract shall be approved prior to repair by the City Kenner. Original equipment manufacturer (OEM) parts and supplies shall be used on repairs and replacements required on equipment included in this Contract. "Repair" services shall be based on the invoice cost of the part (including shipping, if applicable) ~~and a mark-up of 0% of invoice cost.~~ The City reserves the right to purchase all necessary parts in accordance with current City Purchasing Policy and Procedures. The City will solicit bids or proposals for any individual task or work order where the estimate meets or exceeds \$25,000.00 for labor and materials.

Exception: Siddons Martin Emergency Group offers replacement parts at a mark-up of 1.67% over supplier cost.



In reference to Paragraph 4 on Page 5:

~~Payment for replacement of parts not covered under Major and Minor maintenance services (inspections/testing's) shall include the supplier's invoice.~~

Exception: In the event of an audit request made by the customer, Siddons Martin Emergency Group will provide the customer with copies of the supplier invoice for verification.

Replacement of Parts in General

In reference to Paragraph 7 on Page 1 of the General Conditions:

JEFFERSON PARISH requires all products to be new (current) and all work must be performed according to standard practices for the project. Unless otherwise specified, no aftermarket parts will be accepted. Unless otherwise specified, all workmanship and materials must have ~~a at least one (1) year~~ **ninety (90) day** guaranty, in writing, from the date of delivery and/or acceptance of the project. Any deviations or alterations from the specifications must be indicated and/or supporting documentation supplied with bid submission.

Exception: Siddons Martin Emergency Group offers a 90 day warranty on parts and labor. Any warranty offered by a part manufacturer that exceeds 90 days will be passed to the City.

Minor P.M.:

A Minor Preventative Maintenance includes performing a 104 point visual inspection report identifying needed/recommended repairs. Services performed include changing engine oil and oil filter(s), a check of the transmission, pump, differential and coolant fluid levels, and a complete chassis lubrication.

Major P.M.:

A Major Preventative Maintenance includes performing a 104 point visual inspection report identifying needed/recommended repairs. Services performed include changing engine oil, oil filter(s), fuel filter(s), transmission fluid and filters, pump fluid, coolant filter; a test of the coolant; an inspection of the differential fluid, the air dryer, air filter, power steering fluid, and the brakes with wheels on; and a complete chassis lubrication.

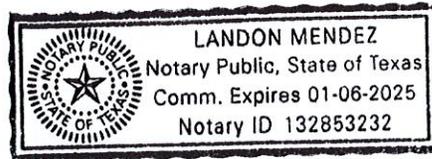
