Fisher Ford Road Repair-Concrete Paving-Approximately 700 LF

- **Compacted aggregate base coarse will be provided by the county.** Contractor will be responsible for checking grades and any fine grading that may be needed for final preparation for concrete paving.
- **Centerline off-set staking will be provided by the county every 50 LF.**
- **Payment for work completed will be made at the unit price bid per linear foot for the length of Concrete Roadway actually paved. Measurement will be made along the centerline of the finished roadway. The unit price bid shall be full compensation for all materials, equipment, labor, and incidentals required to complete the project.**
- All concrete shall be class S(AE) 4000 PSI
- All exposed concrete shall have a broom finish
- Provide transverse control joints @ max spacing of 15' O.C.
- Provide expansion joints every 150 feet and at the end of each days pour
- ½" dia. smooth bars x 24" long set @ 9" O.C. Shall be provided at all expansion/contraction joints.
