

The Natchitoches Parish School Board, Child Nutrition Program, will receive bids on cleaning supplies and paper products for use in the Child Nutrition Program for the 2017 – 2018 School Year.

BID OPENING: Sealed Bids will be accepted until **1:00 p.m., Thursday, May 25, 2017** and will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time in the Child Nutrition Department of the Natchitoches Parish School Board, 300 Parkway Drive, Natchitoches, Louisiana 71457. Bids received after the date and time of opening will not be considered. Facsimile transmissions will not be accepted.
