Generator Silencer Specifications

Labor, materials, and equipment to remove existing silencers and furnish / install new silencers on two (2) Caterpillar Model 3508 diesel engines. Each silencer shall conform to Caterpillar specifications for the Caterpillar Model 3508 diesel engine, and be a Nelson Critical "300" Level Silencer (Part No. 43386) or equal.

5% Bid Bond required

Performance Bond at 50% of Contract Amount

The physical dimensions of the silencers shall allow them to be installed without modifying the existing exhaust piping for the engines at the facility. The vendor shall be responsible for assuring all measurements are correct including but not limited to the inlet diameter, body outside diameter, body length, overall length, centerline offset, inlet length, outlet length, and flanges upon which the silencers shall be attached.

Silencers shall be constructed of carbon steel and mounted on supporting legs.

Installed silencer exhaust outlet shall be positioned in a way that prevents water from entering the unit.

Successful bidder shall provide all rigging to satisfactorily perform and complete the project.

By submitting a bid, vendor agrees to comply with all provisions of Louisiana Law as well be in compliance with the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances, Louisiana Code of Ethics, applicable Jefferson Parish ethical standards and Jefferson Parish Resolution No. 113646 and/or Resolution No. 113647.

All vendors submitting bids should register as a Jefferson Parish vendor if not already yet registered. While Jefferson Parish may have these on file, all bidders should furnish their current W-9 Form and respective Tax Identification Numbers with bid submission; records on file may be invalid or expired. All quotations shall be based on F.O.B. Agency warehouse or job site, anywhere within the Parish as designated by the Purchasing Department. This provision does not apply to public works projects

JEFFERSON PARISH requires all products to be new (current) and all work must be performed according to standard practices for the project. Unless otherwise specified, no aftermarket parts will be accepted. Unless otherwise specified, all workmanship and materials must have at least one (1) year guaranty, in writing, from the date of delivery and/or acceptance of the project. Any deviations or alterations from the specifications must be indicated and/or supporting documentation supplied with bid submission.

Bids may be submitted for products of equal quality, provided brand names and stock numbers are specified. Complete product data may be required prior to award.

C. CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT: JEFFERSON PARISH reserves the right to cancel all or any part if not shipped promptly. No charges will be allowed for parking or cartage unless specified in quotation. The order must not be filled at a higher price than quoted. JEFFERSON PARISH reserves the right to cancel any contract at anytime and for any reason by issuing a THIRTY (30) day written notice to the contractor.




