SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. SCOPE:

- 1.1 The intent of this solicitation is to obtain competitive bids for the estimated annual requirements for **KITCHEN EQUIPMENT** for the Lafayette Parish School System, in accordance with the terms, conditions and specifications contained herein.
- 1.2 **Required Bid Submittals:** The section titled **BID PROPOSAL FORM** and the following supplemental information must be submitted within the time frames specified below.
 - a. **SPECIAL PROVISIONS**, Paragraph 5.2, requires descriptive literature to be provided with the bid if an item is offered as an equal to the brand name specified.

2. **PERIOD OF CONTRACT:**

2.1 The period of this contract shall be from date of award through June 30, 2015.

3. PRICES AND PRICE ADJUSTMENT:

3.1 All prices/discounts shall be F.O.B. Destination and shall include all charges that may be imposed in fulfilling the terms of this contract. Prices/discounts shall remain firm for the duration of the contract.

- 3.2 Whenever there is a reduction in price, which is lower than the contract price, offered to similarly situated customers contracting for the same period and under the same terms and conditions, said, reduction must be presented directly to the Purchasing Department of the Lafayette Parish School System.
- 3.3 Prices may not exceed the national advertised and available General Services Administration (GSA) governmental price list.

4. QUANTITIES:

4.1 The quantities specified on the Pricing Schedule are estimated only, and are given for the information of bidders and for the purpose of bid evaluation. They do not indicate the actual quantity that will be ordered, since such volume will depend upon requirements that develop during the contract period. The Contractor will be required to fill all orders placed regardless of the original quantities shown.

5. **SPECIFICATIONS AND LITERATURE**:

7. TIME OF PERFORMANCE:

7.1 The delivery time required after receipt of the purchase order (ARO) must be stated <u>IN DAYS</u> in the appropriate spaces on the Pricing Schedule. - 8.6 Vendor must install new equipment at time of delivery.
- 8.7 **Installation** means uncrate, set in place, connection of all utilities, removal of debris, and test of operation.
- 8.8 No equipment purchases are accepted as drop shipped.
- 8.9 Plumbing & electrical are provided by Child Nutrition Services.
- 8.10 Vendor must provide demonstration/ in-service of new equipment by qualified personnel to entire kitchen staff at time of installation or other time scheduled with Child Nutrition Services Fixed Asset Coordinator.
