Section 1.0 - Pre-Bid Conference:

All prospective bidders are invited to attend this non-mandatory pre-bid conference. This conference is held to allow questions to be answered and to inspect the site with the owner's representative. Failure to attend the non-mandatory pre-bid conference shall not relieve the bidder of responsibility of information discussed at the conference and the necessity of furnishing all materials, equipment and performing all work required to complete the project in accordance with the specification with no additional cost to the owner.

Section 2.0 – Scope:

We extend this bid to provide labor, materials, delivery, equipment and all other incidentals necessary to perform the following work at the Jefferson Parish First Parish Court Building located at 924 David Drive, Metairie, LA. 70003:

- Remove seven (7) existing light poles
- Remove thirteen (13) existing light fixtures
- Supply and install seven (7) new round tapered aluminum eighteen foot light poles
- Supply and install thirteen (13) new LED light fixtures

Section 3.0 –License Requirements:

The below licenses will be required for this bid:

Section 4.0 Submittals:

All submitted equipment and materials shall be equal to or greater than owner specified.

If bidder intends to provide materials other than specified in Section 7.0. Bidder must include with their bid submittal all literature indicating the submitted equipment and materials are greater than or equal to the owner specifications.

Submittals shall include but not limited to the following information:

- Manufacturer
- Manufacture specifications

 - Pole height

Bidder shall provide with their bid a point by point photometric study.

The photometric study shall include:

- A. Actual locations of poles and fixtures.
- B. Isoquant (ISO)-curves
- C. Photometric plot on 10' x 10' centers.
- D. A Light Loss Factor (LLF) of 0.91 at 50,000 hours or 0.84 LLF at 100,000 hours shall be used to calculate light loss.
- E. Light Loss Factor (LLF) must correspond to TM 21 data
- F. Isoquant (ISO) -curves shall be shown at .50 fc, 1.0 fc and 2.0 fc

Failure to provide the below requested information with bid submission will result in the bid being deemed non-responsive.

Section 5.0 – Quantities/Inspection:

Bidders must inspect the site and perform their own measurements in order to determine the proper quantity of labor and materials and equipment required to complete this project.

Section 6.0 – Bid Specifications:

- All materials shall be bidder supplied new
- All materials shall be as specified or owner reviewed and approved equal before accepting any bids.
- Existing underground wire can be re-used to connect new lights.

6.1 - Removal of existing light poles and light fixtures:

- Remove seven (7) existing light poles with the attached thirteen (13) existing light fixtures
- The removed light poles and light fixtures shall be delivered and offloaded at the Jefferson Parish Surplus Property Facility located at 920 David Drive, Metairie, LA. 70001.

6.2 - Light poles:

- Supply and install one (1) new S1 pole 2208-45805T4C-D1-SBF-LAB Valmont Structures™ 23 foot high round tapered aluminum pole with 4 bolt anchor base. See "Attachment A" for the location of the installation of this pole.
- Supply and install six (6) new S2 poles 2208-45805T4C-D2-SBF-LAB Valmont Structures™ 23 foot high round tapered aluminum pole with 4 bolt anchor base with 180 degrees for light fixtures. See "Attachment A" for the location of the installation of these poles.
- Poles shall be installed as per manufacturer recommendations and guidelines.
- A 4 inch X 6 inch aluminum handhole with cover shall be mounted 18 inches above grade on each pole.
- New handhole shall be watertight.
- Supply and install new properly sized copper wire from existing line voltage wiring to new light fixture on each new light pole.
- Successful Bidder will be responsible for all necessary materials to install poles on existing pedestals with existing 4 bolts.
- Mounting nuts and washers shall be 316 stainless steel.

6.3 – Light fixtures:

- Supply and install one (1) new CREE™ type S1 model OSQ-A-NM-4ME-T-40K-UL-OSQ-DA-SV LED light fixtures with mounting arm on one (1) of the 23 foot light poles. See "Attachment A" for the location of the installation of this pole.
- Supply and install twelve (12) new CREE™ type S2 model OSQ-A-NM-4ME-T-40K-UL-OSQ-DA-SV LED light fixtures with mounting arm on six (6) of the 23 foot light poles. See "Attachment A" for the location of the installation of these poles.

Section 7.0 – Product Description:

Valmont Structures™ pedestal mount 18 foot high round tapered aluminum poles.

8.2 Light Poles Warranty:

Successful bidder shall provide a minimum one (1) year manufacturer warranty on light poles. Warranty information shall be provided on manufacturer letterhead. Warranties shall commence on the acceptance date of the project.

Section 9.0 - Hours of Work:

Work shall be performed during normal working hours Monday thru Friday from 7:00 a.m. thru 6:00 p.m. The successful bidder may choose to work before or after normal building working hours to provide a safe work environment at no extra charge to Jefferson Parish.

Section 10.0 – Cleaning Area and Safety:

Job site must be clean and free of all litter and debris caused by this work daily and upon completion of the contract.

Passageways must be kept clean and free of material, equipment, and debris at all times.

Storage of flammable materials will not be permitted on the premises. All flammable materials must be removed from the job site daily.

Precautions must be exercised at all times to safeguard the welfare and safety of all person(s) and property near the worksite.

Section 11.0 – Existing Structure

Should any cutting, patching, alteration, addition, or repairs to existing parking lot be required of this project, the successful bidder shall restore the area to its original condition, with the same type materials, finish, and workmanship.

Commencing on the thirty-first day following the notice to proceed until work is complete, liquidated damages will be assessed in the amount of \$300 dollars per day.

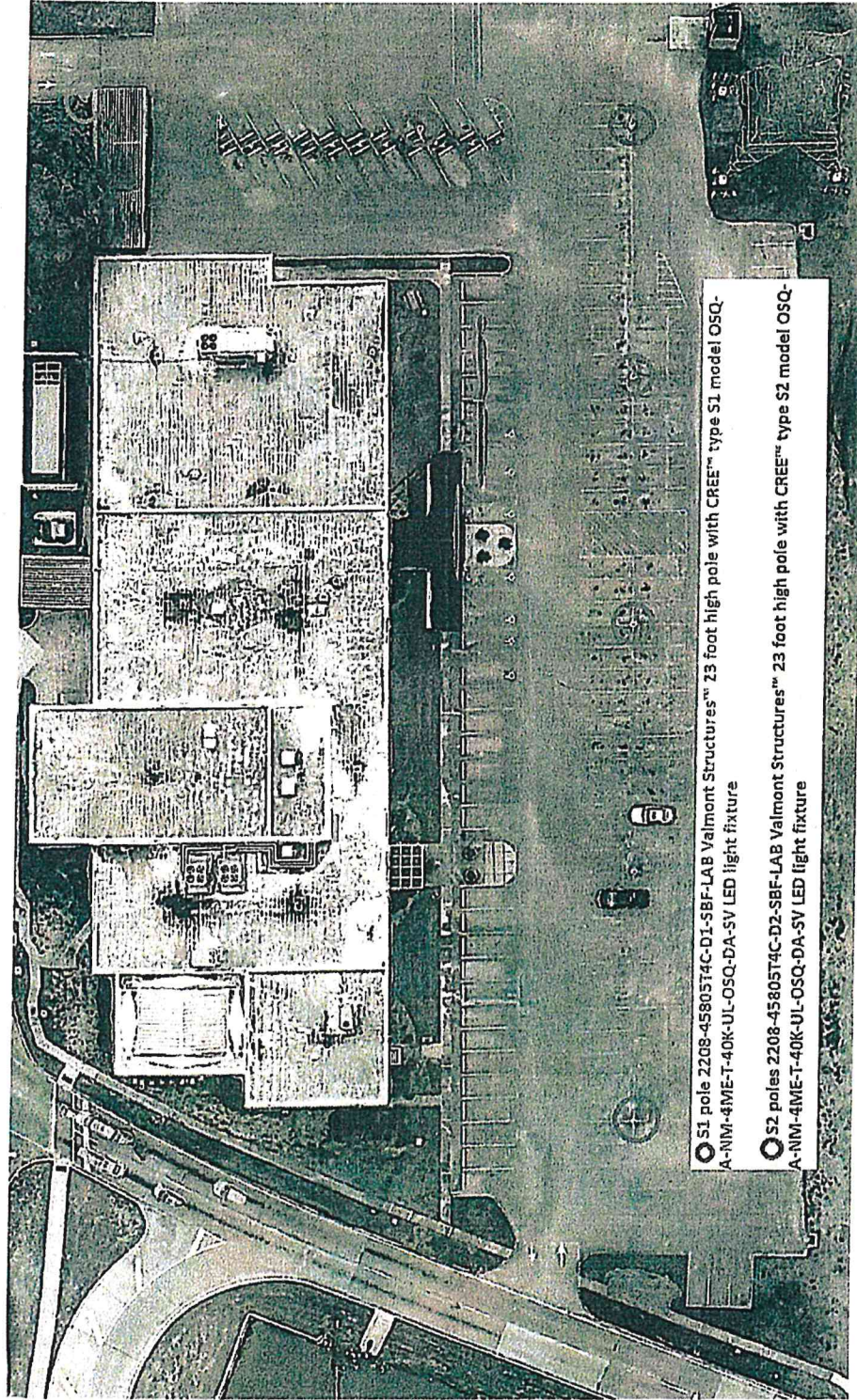


