FRONT VIEW - JEFFERSON PARISH FIRE STATION NO. 13





FRONT VIEW - COLUMN LOCATION







**2) BUILDER'S RISK INSURANCE**

The contractor shall maintain Builder's Risk Insurance at his own expense to insure both the owner (Parish of Jefferson) and contractor as their interest may appear.


