INVITATION TO BID

St. Mary Parish School Board, Child Nutrition Program, is requesting bids on Small Kitchen Equipment for the School Lunch and Breakfast Programs for the 2016/2017 School year, effective August 01, 2016 through May 31, 2017.

Sealed bids will be received at the St. Mary Parish School Board, Central Office Complex, Child Nutrition Program located at 474 LA Hwy 317, mailing address P.O. Box 170, Centerville, Louisiana 70522, **until 4:00 p.m., August 2, 2016. The bids will be opened publicly and read aloud on August 3, 2016 @ 9:00 a.m.**

The St. Mary Parish School Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities.

INSTRUCTIONS, GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS

Bids must be in sealed envelopes addressed to Leonard Armato, Superintendent, St. Mary Parish School Board, Attn: Child Nutrition Department, 474 LA Hwy 317, P.O. Box 170, Centerville, Louisiana 70522, with the envelope plainly marked, "**Sealed Small Kitchen Equipment Bid, Opening 9:00 a.m., August 3, 2016**".

Bids for small kitchen equipment shall be sent by registered or certified mail with a return receipt requested or hand delivered with a written receipt given.

Bids must be submitted on the official attached bid form. Any bid not submitted on this form will be declared irregular and rejected. The entire document must be returned including the Contract section. All certificates included with the bid request must be completed per the instructions and returned with the Bid Proposal Form.

The bid form must be typed or completed in ink. A duly authorized representative of the firm must sign the bid. The person signing the bid must initial any corrections or changes made by erasure, crossing out, writing over or the use of correction fluid. Errors in quoted prices or in preparation of the bid will not relieve the vendor except as provided under Louisiana Revised Statutes.

Any notation on the outside of the sealed bid envelope that is intended to amend the bid in any manner will not be considered.

The bidder shall be solely responsible for timely furnishing of bids. Bids received after the time specified for opening will not be considered, whether delayed in the mail or for any other causes whatsoever. These bids will be returned to the bidder unopened.

Vendors shall quote prices for furnishing and delivering small kitchen equipment to the St. Mary Parish School Board Office located at 474 LA 317 Bayou Sale Rd, Centerville, LA, 70522. Delivery time and date must be given at least 72 hours in advance.

Quoted prices shall not include state or federal sales tax. Price quoted shall remain firm for this period.

This is a Line Item Bid. In the event of a tie bid, the award shall be made by a drawing by lot limited to those bidder. The drawing will be witnessed by three persons, and the contract file shall contain the names and addresses of the witness and the person supervising the drawing.

A written award in the form of a purchase order, contract, written notice of award or any combination of these three to the successful bidder shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party.

Approved brands are listed for some items. When brand name or equal is specified, the Child Nutrition Program and/or Maintenance Department will be the determiner of product equality and all decisions as to equality will be final. Inspection and acceptance of materials or supplies will be made after delivery. Final inspection shall be conclusive except as regards latent defects, fraud, or such gross mistakes as amount to fraud. Final inspection and acceptance or rejection of the materials or supplies will be made as promptly as practicable, but failure to inspect and accept or reject materials or supplies shall not impose liability on the School Board for such materials or supplies as are not in accordance with specifications. All delivered materials shall be accepted subject to inspection and physical count. Any items not meeting the custodial and paper specifications will be shipped back to the vendor at the vendor's expense.

The School Board reserves the right to revoke the contract if service is not satisfactory.

The successful bidder must be authorized by the Secretary of State to do business in Louisiana pursuant to applicable law.

Buy American Provision

Section 104 (d) of the William F. Goodling Child Nutrition Reauthorization Act of 1988 (Public Law 105-336) added a provision, Section 12 (n) to the NSLA (42 USC 1760(n), requiring school food authorities (SFAs) to purchase, to the maximum extent practicable, domestic commodity or product. Section 12(n) of the NSLA defines "domestic commodity or product" as an agricultural commodity that is produced in the United States and a food product that is processed in the United States using substantial agricultural commodities that are produced in the United States. "Substantial" means that over 51 percent of the final processed product consists of agricultural commodities that were grown domestically. Products from Guam, American Samoa, Virgin Islands, Puerto Rico, and the Northern Mariana Islands are allowed under this provision as territories of the United States. The Buy American provision (7 CFR Part 210.219d) is one of the procurement standards SFAs must comply with when purchasing commercial food products served in the school meal programs.

There are limited exceptions to the Buy American provision which are listed below:

1. The product is not produced or manufactured in the U.S. in sufficient and reasonably available quantities of a satisfactory quality.
2. Competitive bids reveal the costs of a U.S. product are significantly higher than the non-domestic product.

To be considered for the alternative or exception, the request must be submitted in writing to the Supervisor of Child Nutrition (Claire Guarisco) a minimum of 10 day(s) in advance of delivery. The request must include the:


1. Alternative Substitute (s) that are domestic and meet the required specifications:
 - a) Price of the domestic food alternative substitute (s)
 - b) Availability of the domestic alternative substitute (s) in relation to the quantity ordered.
2. Reason for the exception: limited/lack of availability or price (include price):
 - a) Price of the domestic food product; and
 - b) Price of the non-domestic product that meets the required specification of the domestic product.

All vendors shall comply with Public Law 105-336. All deviations from Public Law 105-336 should be noted on the bid form.
