By submitting a bid, vendor agrees to comply with all provisions of Louisiana Law as well be in compliance with the Jefferson Parish Code of Ordinances, Louisiana Code of Ethics, applicable Jefferson Parish ethical standards and Jefferson Parish Resolution No. 113646 and/or Resolution No. 113647 as amended.

Jefferson Parish adheres to the Louisiana Code of Governmental Ethics, contained in Louisiana Revised Statutes Annotated, R.S. 42:1101, et seq. Vendor/Proposer by this submission, warrants that there are no "conflicts of interest" related to this procurement that would violate applicable Louisiana Law. Violation of the Louisiana Code of Governmental Ethics may result in rescission of contract, permit or licenses, and the imposition of fines and/or penalties, without contractual liability to the public in accordance with applicable law.

All vendors submitting bids should register as a Jefferson Parish vendor if not already yet registered. JEFFERSON PARISH requires all products to be new (current) and all work must be performed according to standard practices for the project. Unless otherwise specified, no aftermarket parts will be accepted. Unless otherwise specified, all workmanship and materials must have at least one (1) year guaranty, in writing, from the date of delivery and/or acceptance of the project. Any deviations or alterations from the specifications must be indicated and/or supporting documentation supplied with bid submission.

Bidders should submit all questions in writing via email to the buyer's email address as indicated above, no later than Five (5) working days prior to the bid opening. Bid numbers should be mentioned in all requests. If submitting online, vendors may send questions via the E-Procurement site no later than Five (5) working days prior to the bid opening.

AWARD OF CONTRACT:** JEFFERSON PARISH reserves the right to award contracts or place orders on a lump sum or individual item basis, or such combination, as shall in its judgment be in the best interest of JEFFERSON PARISH. Every contract or order shall be awarded to the LOWEST RESPONSIVE and RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, taking into consideration the CONFORMITY WITH THE SPECIFICATIONS and the DELIVERY AND/OR COMPLETION DATE. SPLIT AWARDS MADE TO SEVERAL VENDORS WILL ONLY BE GRANTED TO THOSE DEEMED RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE.

All bid prices shall remain valid for 45 days. Jefferson Parish and the lowest responsive and responsible bidder(s) by mutual written consent may mutually agree to extend the deadline for award by one (1) or more extensions of thirty (30) calendar days.

**PROTESTS:** Only those vendors that submit bids in response to this solicitation may protest any element of the procurement, in writing to the Director of the Purchasing Department. Written protest must be received within 48 hours of the release of the bid tabulation by the Purchasing Department. After consultation, the Parish Attorney's Office will then respond to protests in writing. The price quoted for work shall be stated in figures. In the event there is a difference in unit prices and totals, the unit price shall prevail.

Quantities listed are for bidding purposes only. Actual requirements may be more or less than quantities listed.

1. All bidders must attend the MANDATORY pre-bid conference and will be required to sign in and out as evidence of attendance. Any prospective bidder who fails to attend the conference or remain for the duration shall be prohibited from submitting a bid for the project.
2. Attendance to this pre-bid conference is optional. However, failure to attend the pre-bid conference shall not relieve the bidder of responsibility for information discussed at the conference. Furthermore, failure to attend the pre-bid conference and inspection does not relieve the successful bidder from the necessity of furnishing materials or performing any work that may be required to complete the work in accordance with the specification with no additional cost to the owner.
3. Contractor must hold current applicable JEFFERSON PARISH licenses with the Department of Inspection and Code Enforcement. Contractor acknowledges that, pursuant to Jefferson parish Code of Ordinance Section 2-155.10(19), Contractor, and all of Contractor's Sub-Contractor(s), has an affirmative duty to cooperate with the inspector general in any investigation, audit, inspection, performance review, or hearing.

**SPECIFICATIONS:**

**ARTICLE 1. SERVICES AND REQUIREMENTS**

The Contractor shall furnish all labor, material, equipment, and qualified supervision to control weeds and undesired vegetation on drainage canals, ditches, servitudes, and levees on the east and west bank of Jefferson Parish. This spraying will include treatment of all unwanted broad leafed and grassy weeds, vines, and brush with the intention of elimination of undesirable vegetation. The spraying will be controlled to release low growing grasses such as Bermuda or Centipede on slopes and right-of-ways of certain canals as listed in Article 2 of this bid. All aquatic weeds, rooted or floating in the water, or on the bottom width must be sprayed by boat or other appropriate means. No payment will be made for any work performed in or on any canal not listed in this contract, except changes made by written change order.

After completion of spraying on any areas, and after the required waiting period for its effectiveness to be determined, any areas that indicate poor control or show no effect of the previous spraying shall be retreated within five (5) working days of receipt of telephone notification followed by written notification by the department at no additional cost to the Parish.

Contractor shall be responsible for daily verbal communication with the Drainage Department to advise where work is being performed on those days on which spraying operations are being carried out. Weekly written work reports of spraying performed during the previous week will be submitted by the Contractor to the Drainage Department. These reports will include names of canals, ditches, servitudes, and levees sprayed, square feet (or acres) covered, names of herbicides used and gallons of spray mix used. These reports shall be submitted

promptly each Friday by fax, email, or hand delivered to the East Bank Rheem Building Field Office located at 4901 Jefferson Hwy., Suite "D", Jefferson 70121 and the West Bank LA18 Field Office located at 1561 River Park Rd., Bridge City 70094.

## **ARTICLE 2. ASSIGNED CANALS, DITCHES, AND LEVEES**

Attached is a list of all canals, ditches, and levees within the Parish which may be maintained by contract. Canals are broken down into two (2) spray programs which will require different chemical applications per month. Program 1 will be applications during March, May, July, and September. Program 2 will be applications during April, June, and August. Program 3 will be applications during January, April, July, and September. Each month's application must be completed within that calendar month. After the contract has been awarded and executed by the Parish, the Contractor shall be responsible to verify the acreage shown. Contractor shall contact the Drainage Department supervisor, or the Drainage Director, and after consultation they shall make changes that are agreeable and acceptable to both parties. Verification of acreages shall be completed by the Contractor prior to the start of any work to be done under this contract.

Contractor will be required to include gps navigated boomless sprayers capable of spraying behind vehicles and widths from 5 to 35 feet and computer-controlled flow rate components on all equipment. Spray rigs must be capable of spraying from 20–50 gallons per acre.




