The undersigned BIDDER proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an agreement with OWNER to furnish price quotes for specified materials as indicated in the Procurement Documents for the Bid Price and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Procurement Documents.

2. BIDDER accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Advertisement to Bid.

3. In submitting this Bid, BIDDER represents, as more fully set forth in the Agreement, that:

(a) BIDDER has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents and the following Addenda receipt of all which is hereby acknowledged: (list Addenda by Addendum Number and Date)

(b) BIDDER is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal state and local Laws and Regulations that may effect cost, progress, performance and furnishing of the Materials.

(c) This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed person, firm or corporation and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation; BIDDER has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid; BIDDER has not solicited or induced any person, firm or corporation to refrain from bidding; and BIDDER has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other Bidder or over OWNER.

5. The Parish reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the bidding. The contract, if awarded, will be awarded to the bidder submitting the lowest bid price per foot.

6. Each order against this contract will be by written delivery order to the vendor indicating the bid item, quantity and dollar value, based on the bid price shown on the bid form. No material is to be provided without written delivery order. At the time of delivery the supplier shall provide a written notarized copy of a certification that grade and treatment of materials furnished under this specification shall have been complied with.

7. The Beauregard Parish Police Jury in awarding this contract does hereby agree to procure the items as listed from the vendor to whom the contract is awarded during this twelve month period only.

8. Material ordered under this bid must be provided to the Police Jury within fifteen (15) days from the date order is placed.

10. Unit Price Bid will be F.O.B. to each of the Owner's six (6) Maintenance Yards in Beauregard Parish, LA. The unit price bid shall include all fees and costs required to furnish the materials included in the bid form.

11. In accordance with Act 1029 of the 1991 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature, No State or Local Sales Taxes will be applicable on the purchase of this material.

12. Preference for the purchase of Louisiana products shall be granted in accordance with LA RS 38:2251, paragraph H which reads as follows:

H. Except as otherwise provided in this Section, each procurement officer, purchasing agent, or similar official who procures or purchases materials, supplies, or equipment under the provisions of this Chapter may purchase materials, supplies, or equipment which are Louisiana products, as defined in Paragraph (A)(2) of this Section, and which are equal in quality to other materials, supplies, or equipment, provided that all of the following conditions are met:

NOTE: Paragraph (1) as amended by Acts 2000, 1st Ex. Sess., No. 123, effective until held invalid.

(1) The cost of the Louisiana products does not exceed the cost of other materials, supplies, or equipment which are manufactured, processed, produced, or assembled outside the state by more than ten percent.

NOTE: Paragraph (1) effective if Acts 2000, 1st Ex. Sess., No. 123, is held invalid.

(1) The cost of the Louisiana products does not exceed the cost of other materials, supplies, or equipment which are manufactured, processed, produced, or assembled outside the state by more than seven percent.

(2) The vendor of Louisiana products agrees to sell the products at the same price as the lowest bid offered on such products.

NOTE: Paragraph (3) as amended by Acts 2000, 1st Ex. Sess., No. 123, effective until held invalid.

(3) In cases where more than one bidder offers Louisiana products which are within ten percent of the lowest bid, the bidder offering the lowest bid on Louisiana products is entitled to accept the price of the lowest bid made on such products.

13. Bidder agrees that if awarded the contract, he/she will furnish an executed copy of the Affidavit for Attesting that Public Contract was not secured through employment or payment of solicitor.



BEAUREGARD PARISH POLICE JURY SPECIFICATIONS FOR CORRUGATED METAL CULVERTS

1007.01 CORRUGATED STEEL PIPE AND PIPE ARCH:

These conduits shall conform to the requirements for Type I (culvert pipes circular section) and Type II (culvert pipes, other than circular section) of AASHTO Designation: M 36 amended as follows:

- (a) Pipe and pipe arch shall be galvanized (zinc coated) in accordance with AASHTO Designation: M 218.
- (b) Elbows, tees and other in-line fittings shall be fabricated from sheets of the same thickness and coating material as the pipe or pipe arch to which they are joined. Flared end sections shall be as specified.
- (c) Shop-formed elliptical pipe and shop-strutted pipe shall be furnished when specified.
- (d) When smooth-lined pipe is specified, the inside circumference of the pipe shall be fully lined with bituminous material in accordance with AASHTO Designation: M 190, Type D.
- (e) Helical pipe shall have annular ends and shall have the ends of seams welded a minimum of 2 inches. Helical pipe ends shall be rerolled a minimum of 2 full standard corrugations to the same corrugation depth as the pipe when used with the appropriate jointing systems.
- (f) Pipe joints shall conform to Subsection 1007. 1 0 and shall be as shown on the plans.
- (g) When Type 2 or 3 joints are specified, a minimum of 2 approved lifting lugs shall be provided on pipe larger than 30 inch diameter and pipe arch larger than 3D-inch equivalent diameter.
- (h) All welds and damaged zinc coatings shall be repaired by an approved method with a cold galvanizing repair compound listed on the Qualified Products List.

1007.02 BITUMINOUS COATED CORRUGATED STEEL PIPE AND PIPE ARCH:

These conduits shall be coated in accordance with AASHTO Designation: M 190 amended as follows:

- (a) AASHTO Designation: M 36 is amended in accordance with Subsection 1007.01.
- (b) Coating shall be Type A, fully bituminous coated.
- (c) Pipe joints shall conform to Subsection 1007.03 and shall be as shown on the plans.

1007.03 PIPE JOINTS

Coupling bands for joining metal conduit shall conform to AASHTO Designation: M 36 for steel conduit and AASHTD Designation: M 195 for aluminum conduit with the following modifications:

- (a) Coupling Bands: Bands shall be of an approved design and shall be fabricated from metal sheets of the same material as the conduit. The band thickness shall be the same as the conduit thickness with a maximum of 12 gage. Coating shall be the same as used on the conduit. Minimum band width shall be 12 inches.
- (b) Hardware shall be galvanized in accordance with ASTM Designation: A 153 or B 633, Class Fe/Zn 25 or an approved mechanical galvanizing process that provides the same coating thickness.

LOUISIANA PREFERENCE

NOTE TO BIDDER: In order for preference to be considered, bidder **MUST** complete this document in its entirety and provide it prior to bid opening. Preference submitted on any other document or after the bid opening will not be considered.

PREFERENCE OF PRODUCTS PRODUCED, MANUFACTURED, OR ASSEMBLED IN LOUISIANA

In accordance with the provisions of Louisiana R.S. 39:1604(H) & (I), each procurement officer, purchasing agent, or similar official who procures or purchases materials, supplies, products, provisions, or equipment under the provision of this Chapter may purchase such materials, supplies, products, provisions, or equipment which are produced, manufactured or assembled in Louisiana, as defined below, and which are equal in quality to other materials, supplies, products, provisions, or equipment, provided that all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The cost of such items does not exceed the cost of other items which are manufactured, processed, produced, or assembled outside the state by more than ten percent.
- (2) The vendor of such Louisiana items agrees to sell the items at the same price as the lowest bid offered on such items.
- (3) In cases where more than one bidder offers Louisiana items which are within ten percent of the lowest bid, the bidder offering the lowest bid on Louisiana items is entitled to accept the price of the lowest bid made on such items.

Louisiana preference shall apply only to bidders whose Louisiana workforce is comprised of a minimum of fifty percent Louisiana residents.

For the purposes of this preference, in accordance with R.S. 38:2251(A) the following definitions shall apply:

- (1) "Assembled" means the process of putting together all component parts of an item of equipment by the manufacturer when the assembly plant is located within the territorial borders of the state of Louisiana. "Assembled" shall not mean the process of reassembling parts packed for shipping purposes.
- (2) "Louisiana products" means products which are manufactured, processed, produced or assembled in Louisiana.
- (3) "Manufactured" means the process of making a product suitable for use from raw materials by hand or by machinery. "Manufactured" shall not mean the process of assembling component parts.
- (4) "Processed" means the alteration of any raw product altered from its original state to enhance its value or render it suitable for further refinement or marketing.
- (5) "Produced" means the process of manufacturing, planting cultivating, growing, or harvesting.
