Creating a front door to the facility we were able to mediate the enormous scale of equipment and service vehicles that occupy the site 24 hours a day. The materials of the building represent a careful consideration of image and constructibility; clad with two tones of metal panels, which helps mediate scale issues and delineates interior spaces. 
