Public law 100-237 directs the Secretary of Agriculture to require that whenever possible the Pointe Coupee Parish School Board purchase food products that are produced in the United States. Public Law 100-237 defines American food products as products being grown in America or, in the case of processing or packaging in America, products that contain at least 51 percent of domestic product. Exceptions to the "Buy American" requirement are allowed if the products are not manufactured in the United States in sufficient and reasonably available quantities of a satisfactory quality or if the cost of the domestic produced food products is significantly higher than the cost of the similar foreign products.

1. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS:

- a. At the above time and place bids for milk and related products will be opened and read aloud; the public is invited. All bids shall be submitted sealed to the above address on or before the above time and date. Bids received after the date and time designated for opening of bids or received unsealed will not be considered. Any notation appearing on the outside of the envelope containing the sealed bid which is intended to amend the bid in any manner will not be considered.
- b. Enclosed are bid forms, specifications, and general rules, conditions and instructions for bidders. A list of all schools and the central warehouse is provided in Attachment A. A calendar for the current year is provided in Attachment B. Please complete and sign before returning; the Debarment Certificate in Attachment C, the Certification of Lobbying, Attachment D, and the Disclosure of Lobbying, Attachment E, the Nutrition Analysis form in Attachment F and the Certificate of Independent Price Determination in Attachment G. Bids shall be submitted only on the forms provided. The entire document including specifications and the signed Contract Section must be returned as part of the actual bid.

All information required on the bid form must be supplied to constitute a regular bid. Return only one copy. Bids must be signed by a duly authorized representative of the firm and returned in a sealed envelope marked "SEALED MILK BID" and indicating the date and hour of opening.

- c. The bid form must be typed or completed in ink. The person signing the bid must initial any correction made by erasure or the use of correction fluid.
- d. Bids shall be hand delivered or sent by registered or certified mail. The bidder shall be solely responsible for the timely furnishing of bids. When bids are hand delivered a receipt shall be issued. Please find bid related materials and submit electronic bids at www.centralbidding.com
- e. The quantities of milk and related products specified are only indicative of the board's present estimate based upon quantities used last year. The board binds itself to take and the contractor agrees to supply only what is actually required by the schools for the school session.
- f. The prices quoted shall include handling and deliveries to each school in the parish. A list of all schools and their addresses is provided in Attachment A.
- g. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days following the scheduled opening date.
- h. Bids will not include state or local sales taxes.
- i. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price, the unit price will stand as the bid price.
- j. The school board may use either mini-sip pouches or collapsible gable top cartons and is requesting the price per unit for both types of containers and for the half-pint size of milk.
- k. The opening of bids will be for reading only; award of the bid will be determined within one week of the opening.
- l. Bids will be awarded on an all or none basis to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid for milk in pouches and collapsible cartons is responsive and most advantageous to the school board. The Pointe Coupee Parish School Board reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, and to waive informalities.
- m. One copy of the vendor's bid proposal countersigned by a duly authorized representative of the school board, mailed or delivered to the address given on his/her bid proposal, will be considered sufficient notice of acceptance to bid and award of the contract.
- n. The successful bidder must be authorized by the Secretary of State to do business in Louisiana pursuant to applicable law. Documentation of such authorization must be provided if requested by the school board.

2. SPECIFICATIONS:

- a. All milk and milk products shall meet all requirements of the sanitary code, State of Louisiana, latest revision.

- b. Detailed specifications for milk and related products are provided in Attachment A. Bids must be submitted in strict accordance with the specifications.
- c. The successful bidder agrees to furnish a nutritional analysis for all products bid on the attached nutrition analysis form (Attachment D).
- d. Successful bidder agrees to furnish clean, well-sealed milk cartons or pouches in clean master cases. Milk cartons/pouches and milk cases shall be free from spills, trash, and the odor of sour milk.
- e. All refrigerated milk and milk products shall be date codes and all items shall have at least seven (7) days remaining on the date code when delivered.
- f. Successful bidder will deliver milk in refrigerated trucks and place the milk, in the cases, in the refrigerated milk box in the cafeteria. Refrigerated product temperatures shall not exceed 40 degrees Fahrenheit not shall they be less than 32 degrees Fahrenheit. Frozen products shall be maintained at temperatures not to exceed 5 degrees Fahrenheit.
- g. At the time of each delivery, all milk in the milk box is to be placed on top of the milk delivered that day.
- h. Deliveries for milk and milk products except ice cream are to be made three times a week or daily, as specified (see attachment) Monday through Friday, except school holidays. Deliveries for ice cream and fruit juices are to be made only as requested. A school calendar (Attachment B) is included for your information. The time of day for delivery will be negotiated upon award of the bid and shall be mutually acceptable and advantageous to both parties.
- i. The contractor is required to provide the service described in contract documents. Should a strike or lock out occur, the contractor is not relieved of his responsibilities to fulfill the terms of the contract.
- j. Orders for milk and related products shall originate from the cafeteria manager in each school.
- k. The dairy agrees to be responsible for damage to milk boxes or refrigerators, buildings and grounds that are a direct result of carelessness of the delivery person.
- l. Successful vendors shall be required to leave duplicate invoices with the representative who receives the items at each respective school.
- m. The Pointe Coupee Parish School Board, the Louisiana Department of Education, the United States Department of Agriculture, the Comptroller General of the United States, or any of their duly authorized representatives, may have access to any books, documents, papers and records or the contractor which are directly pertinent to this specific contract for the purpose of making audit, examination, excerpts, and transcriptions.

3. ESCALATION/DE-ESCALATION CLAUSE:

Product specifications included herein shall be made firm for the entire period of the contract. The prices for milk specifications included herein shall be firmed for 30 days from the date of the bid opening. Subsequent prices for these milk products may escalate or de-escalate in accordance with the changes in the Class I monthly total raw milk price components (Skim Milk and Butterfat) to the manufacturer as stated by the Announcement of Class Prices for 3.5% Milk for the New Orleans, LA area. The vendor awarded the contract shall provide 10 days prior written notice to any change. A copy of the Milk Market Administrator's Announcement and any other announced price changes shall be furnished with the written notification. Any change in price will commence on the first day of the month subsequent to the receipts of the written notification.

For bid purposes, the present cost of components for the month of May is \$ 13.5969 /cwt. for skim and \$ 4.4545 /lb. for butterfat to equal \$18.0514/cwt. of 3.5% Class I Milk.

4. SUBCONTRACTING:

Subcontracting of part of this bid by the successful bidder to other responsible entries (e.g., dairies) is permitted as hereinafter provided

- a. Subcontractors shall be regularly in the dairy business and have the capability to fulfill and deliver that part of the work as may be let to them.
- b. All subcontractors shall have the prior approval of the school board before the effective date of this bid.
- c. The successful bidder must detail to the school board the quantity of business, method of distribution, and schools served by the subcontractor to the full and complete satisfaction of the school board.

5. FAILURE TO DELIVER - DAMAGES:

If the contractor fails to deliver milk within the mutually agreed upon time schedule and if such failure results in the school board being unable to serve a reimbursable meal, the contractor agrees to pay the school board for any and all losses of state and federal reimbursement withheld from the school lunch and/or breakfast programs. (Regulations require the offering of both unflavored whole and unflavored low fat milk to every child.)

6. INSPECTION AND TESTS:

The school board reserves the right to have any milk and related products inspected at any time by the Pointe Coupee Parish Department of health and Human Resources. Any items condemned or rejected as a result of any inspection by the Department of Health and Human Resources or as determined by any of the board's employees, shall be immediately replaced if discovered in time to be provided in the Board's School Breakfast and School Lunch Programs. If the board is unable to serve milk in the program because the products delivered by the contractor are unsuitable for consumption, the contractor agrees to reimburse the board for

any and all losses of state and federal reimbursement withheld from the school lunch and/or breakfast programs. The contractor is not responsible for any damage to the milk supplies caused by the school board, its officers, agents or employees or by the malfunctioning of any of the school board's equipment utilized for the storage of milk after delivery.

7. CANCELLATION OF ORDERS:

The school board reserves the right to cancel any orders or portion thereof which a vendor fails to deliver at the time specified.

8. TERMINATIONS:

- a. This contract may be terminated on thirty(30) day's notice upon the mutual agreement of both parties, or at any time if the terms of the contract are violated in any way.
- b. Repeated failure to make delivery in accordance with specifications will result in the termination of the contract and/or disqualification of the vendor until such time as he/she furnishes satisfactory evidence that future obligations can be fulfilled. Failure to render prompt service will be considered in making subsequent awards.

9. STATEMENTS:

Statements shall be submitted monthly to the School Food Service Department no later than seven (7) days after the month in which delivery was made. Each statement shall contain a record of all purchases, by school, for the month (in chronological order with invoice number listed).

10. PAYMENT:

Payment will be made by invoice only. All invoices will be paid within twenty (20) days after correct monthly statements have been received.
