



This Addendum No. 1 consists of (21) pages.

**GENERAL**

1. The mandatory pre-bid conference was held on March 10, 2016 at 10:00 am. The sign-in sheet (3 pages) is attached and hereby made part of this addendum.

## **SPECIFICATIONS**

1. The Louisiana Uniform Public Work Bid Form (LUPWBF) has been revised and is attached to this addendum. The attached LUPWBF sheets (pages 1 through 10) shall govern and replace any previous versions. All bidders **MUST** use the attached sheets and make sure the revised LUPWBF has the words “**Revised per Addendum No. 1**” in the header of **EVERY** page. No other versions will be accepted. Changes to the Bid Form:
  - a. Added Bid Item No. S-007. “Site Survey”.
2. Sp.52 Site Survey, pages SP-12 thru SP-14, of the Specifications has been revised to include interior videos of residences, created a new pay item for Site Survey, and created a measurement and payment section.

## **CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS**

**Q-1) Is this a Davis Bacon/certified payroll project?**

A-1) No

**Q-2) Who is to pay for testing?**

A-2) Jefferson Parish will hire and pay for an independent testing lab. See SP.08, Page SP-1 of the Specifications.

**Q-3) Special Provision #42 – Clean & TV Existing Storm Drain and Sewer Lines and Pay Item S-906: Are both the storm drain and sewer lines included in Pay Item S-906?**

A-3) There are separate pay items for storm drain and sewer. Item No. S-003, “Pre-Construction Pipe Cleaning and Video Inspection (Existing storm sewer lines 24” and under)” is for storm drains only. Item No. S-906, “Pre-Construction and Post-Construction Pipe Cleaning and Video Inspection”, is for sewer only.

**Q-4) Will contractor be responsible for post-video of all new drain and sewer lines?**

A-4) Post-video of all new drain and sewer lines is not required. However cleaning may be required as directed by the Engineer or the Parish. Payment for any cleaning of new storm drain or sewer will be borne by the contractor.

**Q-5) Will an engineer-stamped trench box be allowed in lieu of shoring for the drainage construction?**

A-5) The contractor will be allowed to dictate his own means and methods of Construction, however he must satisfy all aspects of the construction plans and specifications, while maintaining current OSHA standards.

**Q-6) The plans don’t show the depth of the water lines, neither for the one to remove or the new one to install. What is the depth of those lines?**

A-6) Existing waterlines are to be assumed at 3’-4’ of cover. New waterlines are to be installed as per sheet 302 of the Construction Plans and Appendix C of the Specifications.

**Q-7) Most sewer crossings are composed of a Ductile Iron section and a PVC C-900 section (example page 15) but the limits of each section are often unclear. What is the intend for both type of lines so we can evaluate how much of each will be installed? If the PVC section is only a few feet long, would it be switch to DI to avoid an additional DI/PVC transition?**

A-7) See sheets 30-39 of the Construction Plans. Each conflict box detail depicts the length of ductile iron pipe. The contractor shall use PVC-C900 beyond the limits of ductile iron pipe shown.

**Q-8) Is crushed concrete acceptable for bedding?**

A-8) Item No. 302-02-02080, "Class II Base Course (6" Thick) (Stone)" shall be stone only. Item No. 726-01-00100, "Bedding Material" for storm drains shall be per sheet No. 305 of the construction plans.

**Q-9) What is the compaction required for the #57 bedding?**

A-9) Item No. 302-02-02080 "Class II Base Course (6" Thick) (Stone) shall be 95% (min) of Maximum Density (DOTD TR418). Item No. 726-01-00100, "Bedding Material" #57 crushed Limestone/Recycled PCC shall be at 75% of Relative Density (ASTM-D-7253 & D 4254).

**Q-10) Can a bid item be added for Pre-Construction video and photos?**

A-10) A new bid item has been included. Item No. S-007, "Site Survey". Documentation of the interior of residences or buildings is required. Permission of the land owner to access the interior of residence or building is required and the responsibility of the Contractor.

**Q-11) Does the Parish have any areas available for the Construction job site trailer?**

A-11) No, Contractors from previous phases utilized vacant lots/areas with written permission from landowner.

**Q-12) Will this project require a flagman for Temporary Traffic Control?**

A-12) No, not specifically, however, there may be times when a flagger is required when mobilizing materials to jobsite.

**Q-13) Can a pre cast option be used for the conflict boxes?**

A-13) No, pre-cast boxes will not be allowed for "conflict" boxes.

**Q-14) What type of Geotextile fabric is required for the roadway and storm drainage?**

A-14) Non-woven Class D fabric is required for the roadway. See sheet 305 of the Construction Plans for the allowable Geotextile fabric for storm drainage.

**Q-15) Would the contractor be allowed to use a portion of Jefferson Parish property, at the water plant facility, located between Avenue C and Avenue D, to stage the required office trailer for this project's resident inspector?**

A-15) No, Contractors from previous phases utilized vacant lots/areas with written permission from landowner.

**Q-16) In Section "SP.42- Clean and TV existing Storm Drains and Sewer Lines," of the Special Provisions, seems to be an area of concern for the Owner, and they have created two (2) bid items:**

**S-003: Pre-Construction and Post Construction Pipe Cleaning and Video Inspection (Existing Storm Sewer Lines 24" and Under)**

**S-906: Pre-Construction and Post Construction Pipe Cleaning and Video Inspection (Sanitary Sewer)**

**Would the Owner consider making a bid item for a "Pre-Construction of Residential and Public Buildings Immediate to the Work Area", since the size of the excavation will affect at**



Would the Owner consider making a bid item for a “Pre-Construction of Residential and Public Buildings Immediate to the Work Area”, since the size of the excavation will affect at least 50% or more of the public right-of-way? The residential buildings are very dense in number and the majority of them are non-pile supported structures, on brick piers. In the Special Provisions, Section SP-52: “Site Survey” you first sentence states “Prior to mobilization on the jobsite, the Contractor shall conduct a detailed survey that shall include pre-construction photographs and video of the jobsite, surrounding areas, and access and/or haul routes,” and the closing sentence “There shall be No Measurement or Direct Payment for services required by this provision”. Since this provision was such a concern in the Special Provisions, would you consider creating a bid item similar to bid items S-003 and S-906, and include provisions to document the interior of residences and buildings?

A-16) See response to Q-10.

**Q-17) Under the headings and details for Pipe Bedding Materials and Class II Base Course, you call out limestone or stone to be used. Is “Recycled Portland Cement Concrete” of the proper gradations an acceptable, alternative material for Pipe Bedding and/or Class II Base Course?**

A-17) Recycled PCC can be used as an alternate for pipe bedding, however, it cannot be used for Class II Base Course.

**Q-18) Bid Items: 702-01-00100-A thru 702-01-00100-J Junction Boxes (Conflict Box “A thru J”) and Item 702-02-00100, Manholes (MH-06) are detailed on Plan Sheets: 24-29 (Junction Box Details), 30-38 (Conflict Box Details), and 208 (MH-06) as being intended to be “Poured-In-Place Structures”, and the question was asked at the pre-bid meeting if “Precast Structures” were an approved alternate method of construction. The project engineer’s response was that due to the possible unknown existing utility lines that precast structures may be difficult to use. Therefore, on Plan Sheet 304, is a detail for “Jefferson Parish, Department of Engineering’s Conflict Structures”, which are a combination of brick walls and concrete bottom and deck slabs. Can Contractor choose this method of construction to build the “Junction Boxes (Conflict Box A thru J)” and use precast concrete structures for the “Manholes (MH-06)”?**

A-18) Pre-Cast structures will not be allowed for conflict boxes, manholes and junction boxes. Contractor shall use the details provided on sheet 30-39 of the Construction Plans for the construction of the conflict boxes.

**Q-19) On Bid Item: 701-03-01000 Storm Drain Pipe (15” RCP); instead of 15” RCP can the contractor use 15” A-2000? 15” A-2000 is on the State QPL and also has been installed on Jefferson Parish Drainage projects in the past.**

A-19) A-2000 is an allowable alternative for pipes 36” and under. However, keep in mind PVC (A-2000) pipe will not be allowed under the roadway section. Please see sheet 305 of the Construction Plans for allowable materials and PVC pipe trench details.

**Q-20) On Bid Item 740-02-00100 Utility Oversight and Coordination, will a unit price be provided?**

A-20) No

**Q-21) Will Builder’s Risk and Owner’s Protective Liability Insurance be required for this project?**

A-21) No

**Q-22) The trench details page 305 show a PVC pipe for 36" and under, but the bid form item only mentions RCP. Can PVC pipe be used for up to 36"?**

A-22) See response to Q-19.

**Q-23) What are the bedding requirements under the junction/conflict boxes A to J?**

A-23) See sheet 16 of the Construction Plans.

**Q-24) We feel that video-recording of the neighborhood houses is needed due to the scale of the excavation. Would an additional item be added for this?**

A-24) See response to Q-10.
