Following please find the response of Ready2Go Restroom Trailers Sales, LLC ("R2G") to the above referenced bid.

1. As a point of clarification, the Bid Document, Section 3.0 Unit Description, refers to "Oahu Series SKU#CHS19490". This is the stock number used by a dealer - Portable Restroom Trailers – for the Comforts of Home (manufacturer) ADA+4 shower/restroom trailer. R2G also carries Comforts of Home trailers, and this particular model is also on our website (www.ready2gorestroomtrailers.com) under stock #AA-412432-ASC. Comforts of Home uses the stock number 6502NB.
2. Subject to Paragraph 3 below, R2G's response meets all the requirements cited in the bid documents.
3. The sole variance between R2G's response and the Specifications is the size of the waste tank. Comforts of Home's ADA+4 Shower/Combo is built with a 600 gallon waste tank; a 750 gallon is not available.

Common methods of reducing the number of waste tank pump-outs are:

- a. Installing diverter valves on the shower drains, thereby enabling the 'gray' water to flow through a hose and empty into a field, storm drain, etc;
- b. Utilization of a bladder bag (<https://www.readycontainment.com/>)
- c. Direct connect to nearby sewer/septic field (see enclosed attachment).

4. In addition to the above referenced warranties, R2G also provides technical support for the life of the trailer. The President of R2G, Mark Rosen, is available at anytime to respond to technical queries pertaining to trailers sold by R2G. His cell phone number is provided to all customers.
5. Terms: Net 30
6. Delivery is anticipated 14 weeks after receipt of order.

The warrantor guarantees the product against defects in materials and workmanship. The warranty described in this agreement is in lieu of all other warranties, expressed or implied from **Ready2Go Restroom Trailers Sales, LLC** or its suppliers. This warranty shall apply to the retail consumer (original purchaser), as shown on the sales agreement.

Certain individual components are warranted by their respective manufacturers' warranties and therefore are excluded from the limited warranty provided by the warrantor. These components include, but are not limited to; tires, wheels, axles, couplers, jacks, light fixtures, windows, doors, heaters, toilets, sinks, faucets, pumps, etc. Warranty claims must be filed with the respective component manufacturer's warranty department.

Direct to Sewer Option for Restroom Trailers with Holding Tank:

You will need a “Trash Pump” (i.e., a pump that will remove the solid waste from the holding tank along with the liquids; see *below for recommended brand*). A plumber should connect the pump and hose to the sewer.

Trailer will have to be monitored:

1. Wait until holding tank on trailer is at least half full.
2. Open the clean out valve on trailer and turn on trash pump.
3. Follow the directions for the pump according to the owner’s manual.
4. After tank is empty turn off the pump then close the cleanout valve on the trailer.
5. It is important to monitor the pump while the waste is being emptied into the sewer.
6. Never leave the pump running after waste has been emptied.

VERY IMPORTANT: Leaving pump on after waste has been removed can cause damage to holding tank.

Flushing out the Holding Tank: perform as needed to control odor and buildup of solids.

1. If possible, adjust the stabilizing jacks to slant trailer towards the clean out valve.
2. Insert a water hose in the toilet on highest end of trailer (or furthest from clean out valve)
3. Turn on water to full flow
4. Let the holding tank fill to at least half full. Then follow same steps as above to empty into sewer.
5. Of course, you will have to re-level the trailer when completed.

HINT: Keeping Tank Fresh- Using a tank deodorizer can help control odor.

IMPORTANT: This option is for purchase only (rentals must always use a trash pump).

Gravity Option:

The Gravity Option (i.e., without a trash pump) is not ideal, but it will get the job done. It is recommended to have a plumber connect trailer to the sewer. The gravity option does not work on ADA trailers that are lowered to the ground.

1. Wait until holding tank on trailer is almost full or at least half full. *(the fuller the better to let the liquids help wash out the solids.)*
2. Then open the clean out valve on trailer and let waste flow into the sewer.
3. This option does run the risk of some solids being left behind which will cause an odor.

HINT: Lowering the trailer with the stabilizing jacks towards the corner of trailer where the clean out valve is located will help with the gravity option. Of course, you will have to re-level the trailer when completed.

Flushing out the Tank: Do as needed to control odor and buildup of solids.

4. If you can, lower the trailer with the stabilizing jacks towards the clean out.
5. Then insert a water hose in the toilet on highest end of trailer on full flow.
6. Let the holding tank fill at least half way. Then open clean out valve to sewer. Repeat if needed until all solids are washed out.

HINT: You may consider changing toilets to full flush toilets if you intend to keep trailer hooked up to sewer permanently.


