**Safety Factors**

**As per UL Standard 19:** - A direct fire test is the safe performance of the fire hose. The UL abrasion test most closely resembles the fire ground use of that hose and as such is considered of prime importance. Hose meeting all of the Division resistance safety factors below shall pass without exceeding average weight.

**UL Abrasion:** - The hose shall pass a burst test after 5000 cycles on the reporting abrasion tester - as specified in UL Standard 19.

**UL Standard 19:** - The hose shall be capable of safe use during 105°F fire exposure with no apparent damage to cover. After exposure, being water subjected to the following cold flexibility test: a 60' length of hose is coiled and placed in a cold box at 65°F for a duration of 24 hours. Immediately after removal of the hose from the box, hose should be uncoiled and laid out by one operator.

**UL Standard 19:** - Heat resistance is of the utmost importance when evaluating interior attack hoses. The hose shall meet the standard for heat resistance without exceeding the normal fire hose weight.

**UL Standard 19:** - The tendency for a hose to absorb water while in service when evaluating interior attack hoses. The hose shall meet the standard for water absorption can create significant handling difficulties. When tested against the procedure listed in MIL-H-24606 latest edition, the maximum weight gain shall not exceed 3 pounds per 60' length.

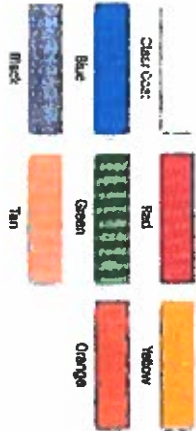
**Inside Diameter**

This radiused inside diameter of Combat Sniper hose shall be 1.78" respectively with a clearance of 1.2% when measured according to UL Standard 19.

This hose is designed specifically for aggressive fire attack operations and is recommended for low pressure water applications. The cover, which is woven from high strength polyamide fibers over an inner reinforcement of a composite sandwich through-the-weave rubber/PC-L208. Cover on these coverings is made of 100% 100% PVC. The cover is standard Combat Sniper is manufactured in a high-velocity fashion with four black and green stripes running the length of the hose. This heat, abrasion and tear resistant hose shall have superior friction loss characteristics. Lengths available up to 75'. Warranty: Hose shall carry a 10-year written warranty, which includes a 1-year all hazards warranty.

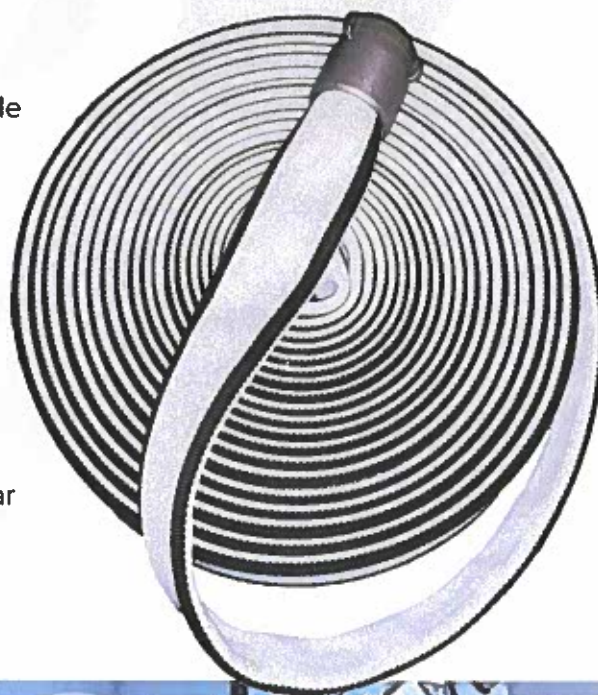
