Per your email dated February 6, 2018, you have agreed, concerning our self-insurance


- Goodyear's self-insurance is acceptable to the Parish. We are including an example of our certificate of insurance, and, our letter stating our self-insurance retention of \$3,000,000 retention for general liability.
- The Parish indicated that by Goodyear having the self-insurance retention noted above that the "deductibles" requirement stated in the Insurance Requirements does not apply.
- Goodyear's commercial automobile policy is sufficient, and includes Bodily injury liability \$1,000,000.00 each person; \$1,000,000.00 each occurrence; and Property Damage Liability \$1,000,000.00 each occurrence.

Per your email dated February 7, 2018, we understand that though expressly noted in the bid, Parish Resolution 113647 (Terms & Conditions) are not applicable to this solicitation.

Goodyear CT&SC proposes certain changes to the terms and conditions to reflect our concerns for the liability provisions stated by the Parish. Please see our Attachment #1 to this letter with our request for exception, change or modification of the bid terms and conditions.

**General Instructions, Part C, Anti-Trust**

Goodyear requests that the antitrust provisions of Paragraph Two of this Part be deleted. Goodyear is the manufacturer for all the tires bid or is an approved dealer for the tires bid including the tubes.

We make this request because anti-trust claims are often related to raw materials and it is difficult to determine to what extent Jefferson Parish was affected (if at all) and what "part" of the claim would be assigned. The bid prices are firm, net prices. Goodyear did not price the bid on a cost+ basis, nor was that bid requirement, which is when this would have any effect on Jefferson Parish. The logistics of tracking exactly what/if any portion of our claim that Jefferson Parish would be owed would be cost prohibitive and time consuming. Because we generally "eat" any price increase that would result from an anti-trust violation, there isn't an effect on the pricing for Jefferson Parish (or any of our customers).

Goodyear requests that the following language be deleted:

~~For good cause and as consideration for executing a contract with Jefferson Parish, vendor conveys, sells, assigns and transfers to Jefferson Parish or its assigns all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of Louisiana, relating to the particular good or services purchased or acquired by Jefferson Parish.~~




