Section 1.0 – Site Visit:

Section 2.0 – Scope:

We extend this proposal to provide labor, materials, equipment, tools, and other incidentals necessary to remove and properly dispose of the existing gutter system and supply and install new aluminum gutters around the Metairie Senior Center located at 265 North Causeway Boulevard, Metairie, LA 70001

Section 3.0 –License Requirements:

License(s) issued by the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors:

- Building Construction

Section 4.0 – Quantities/Inspections:

Bidders must inspect the site and perform their measurements to determine the proper quantity of labor and materials, and equipment required to complete this project.

Section 5.0 - Bid Specifications:

- All materials shall be bidder-supplied new.
- All materials shall be installed as per all manufacturer recommendations and guidelines.
- Any concealed damage must be reported immediately to the owner.
- No work to conceal damages shall be performed without approval.

5.1 Before work begins:

- Successful bidder and an owner's representative shall inspect, document, and take photos of existing building conditions.
- Remove and properly dispose of the existing canopy and all associated materials.

5.2 Installation of gutters:

- Design, engineer, supply, and install one new aluminum gutter system.
- Supply and install standard extruded aluminum gutters.
- Gutters shall be mounted with matching hardware per manufacturer recommendations.
- Color must match existing building finishes.

Section 6.0 – Hours of Work:

The work to be performed shall be scheduled during regular working hours Monday thru Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Section 7.0 – Material and Workmanship Warranty:

All materials and workmanship shall have a one (1) year warranty in writing from the manufacturer.

A copy of all warranties shall be provided to the owner at the completion of the project.

All warranties shall commence at the completion of the project.

Section 8.0 – Existing Structure

Suppose the successful bidder should damage or destroy any part of a building, etc. The successful bidder shall be required to replace and restore said item to its original condition, with the same type of material, finish, and workmanship, at no additional cost to the owner.

Section 9.0 – Permits:

Bidder shall obtain any permits required by the Jefferson Parish Department of Inspection and Code Enforcement and any municipality where work is performed.

The bidder shall be responsible for the payment of these permits. All permits must be obtained before the start of any project requiring permits.

Section 10.0 – Liquidated Damages:

Commencing on the thirty-first (31) day following the notice to proceed, liquidated damages will be assessed in the amount of \$300/day.

Section 11.0 – Start of Work Conference and Notice to Order Materials and Notice to Proceed:

- A "Start of Work Conference" shall be held between the successful bidder and the owner before any work commences.
- No Materials shall be ordered until the successful bidder receives a written "Notice to Order Materials" from the Department of General Services.
- No work shall be performed until the successful bidder receives a written "Notice to Proceed" to begin work from the Department of General Services.

STANDARD INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDING PURPOSES

All required insurance under this bid shall conform to Jefferson Parish Resolution No. 113646 or No. 113647, as applicable. Contractors may not commence any work under any ensuing contract unless and until all required insurance and associated evidentiary requirements thereto have been met, along with any additional specifications contained in the **Invitation to Bid**. Except as where otherwise precluded by law, the Parish Attorney or his designee, with the concurrence of the Director of Risk Management or his designee, may agree on a case-by-case basis, to deviate from Jefferson Parish's standard insurance requirements, as provided in this Section. Vendors requesting deviation therefrom shall submit such requests in writing, along with compelling substantiation, to the Purchasing Department prior to the bid's due date. Any changes to the insurance requirements will be reflected in the bid specifications and addenda. Prior to contract execution and at all times thereafter during the term of such contract, contractors must provide and continuously maintain all coverages as required by the foregoing Resolutions, and the contract documents. Failure to do so shall be grounds for suspension, discontinuation or termination of the contract.

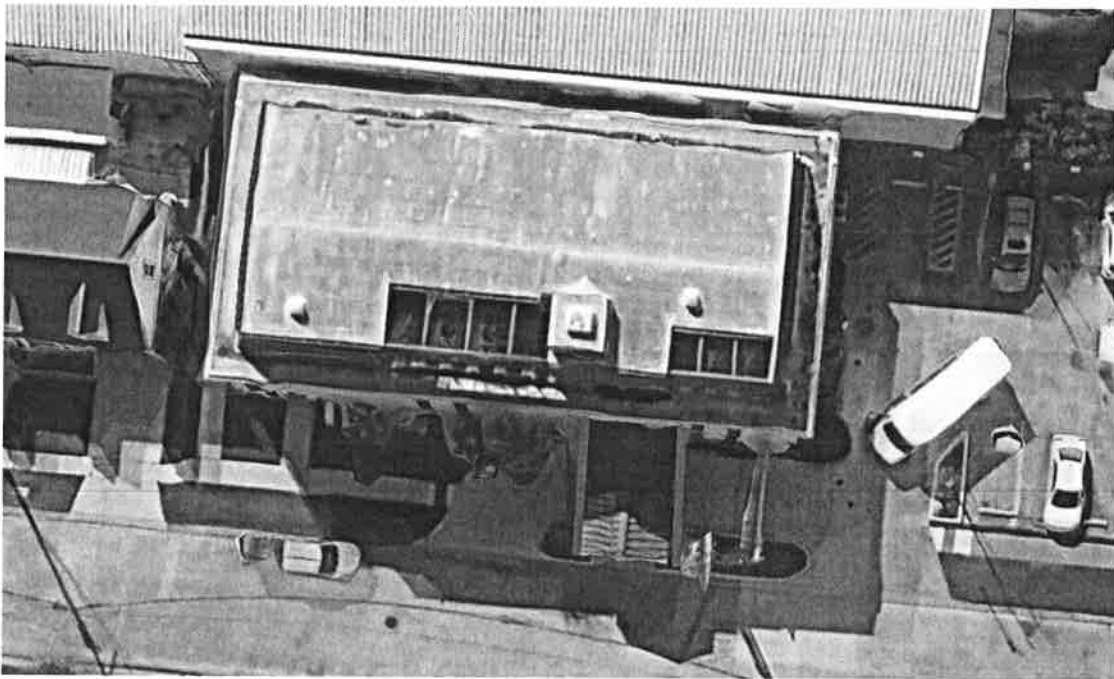
